

NORTH 1/16 CORNER NORTHWEST 1/4 SECTION 27, TOWNSHIP 16 SOUTH, RANGE 10 EAST

- 1) MATTHEW BROWN, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1888 TO 1900, AND 1914, IN SURVEY NUMBER 165, AN **AGREEMENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "F" ON PAGE 135 DATED JULY 10-13, 1888 FOR LESTER NOPPER AND F. WILLIAMSON TO ESTABLISH THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF THE NORTHWEST 1/4, THE CORNERS OF THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 OF THE NORTHWEST 1/4, AND THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 , ALL IN SECTION 27, TOWNSHIP 16, RANGE 10, SAID THAT **HE SET A 20" X 8" X 3" LIMESTONE MARKED "1/8" ON THE NORTH SIDE** FOR THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 27-16-10 ON LINE AND HALFWAY BETWEEN THE STONE THAT HE FOUND AT THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 27-16-10 AND THE FLAG THAT HE SET FOR THE NORTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 27-16-10 ON THIS **AGREEMENT SURVEY**. THIS SURVEY WAS FILED IN VOLUME 41 ON PAGE 414 ON OCTOBER 18, 1888 IN THE REGISTER OF DEEDS OFFICE AND SURVEY F27001 IN THE SURVEY FILE FOR TOWNSHIP 16-10 IS A COPY OF THE RECORDED SURVEY.

HIS SURVEY NOTES SHOW THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- 1) 1,309.25' WEST TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 27-16-10
- 2) 1,309.25' EAST TO THE FLAG HE SET FOR THE NORTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 27-16-10
- 3) 3,927.75' EAST TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 27-16-10
