

**WEST 1/16 CORNER NORTHEAST 1/4 SECTION 33, TOWNSHIP 16 SOUTH, RANGE 10 EAST**

- 1) ALVA J. SMITH, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1900 THROUGH 1906, IN SURVEY NUMBER 77, A **PERMANENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "F" ON PAGE 157 DATED JULY 7, 1903 AT THE REQUEST OF STEPHEN SIFFIES FOR A SURVEY FOR THE PURPOSE OF LOCATING AND PERMANENTLY ESTABLISHING THE CORNERS AND BOUNDARIES OF THE SOUTH 1/2 OF THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 28 AND THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF THE NORTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 33, ALL IN TOWNSHIP 16 AND RANGE 10 AND RUN SUCH LINES AS ARE NECESSARY TO PROPERLY COMPLETE THE WORK, SAID THAT **HE FOUND THE STONE** AT THE WEST 1/2/4 CORNER OF THE NORTHEAST 1/4 SECTION 33-16-10 ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**. HIS FIELD NOTES ARE IN BOOK 3 ON PAGE 184 IN THE "KRETSINGER COLLECTION" OF FIELD BOOKS, AND THERE IS ADDITIONAL INFORMATION IN PACKET "M 160" IN MISCELLANEOUS DRAWER NUMBER 8 IN THE VAULT IN THE COUNTY ENGINEER'S OFFICE.

**HIS SURVEY NOTES/DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:**

- 1) 17.31 CHAINS EAST TO THE 20" X 12" X 8" STONE DRESSED WITH A CHISELED SQUARE ON TOP HE SET FOR A PERMANENT PROPERTY CORNER
- 2) 40.31 CHAINS EAST TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE EAST 1/2/4 CORNER OF THE NE1/4 OF SECTION 33-16-10 THAT WAS "SET BY UNKNOWN PARTIES"
