DeCAMP TO SURVEY SECTIONS 2, 3 & 4 IN TOWNSHIP 16, RANGE 11, SAID THAT **HE SET A STONE** FOR THE PERMANENT CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 3-16-11 ON LINE BETWEEN THE STONE THAT HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT NORTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 3-16-11 ON THE 3RD STANDARD PARALLEL AND THE STONE THAT HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT SOUTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 3-16-11, AND AT 40.00 CHAINS NORTH OF THE SOUTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 3-16-11 ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**.

HIS SURVEY NOTES SHOW THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- 1) 41.16 CHAINS NORTH TO THE STONE HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT NORTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 3-16-11 ON THE 3RD STANDARD PARALLEL
- 2) 40.00 CHAINS SOUTH TO THE STONE HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT SOUTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 3-16-11
- 3) 19.90 CHAINS EAST TO THE STONE HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT SOUTH 1/8TH CORNER OF THE NE1/4 OF SECTION 3-16-11
- 4) 39.80 CHAINS EAST TO THE STONE HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT EAST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 3-16-11
