- 1) C. H. RICE, DEPUTY COUNTY SURVEYOR, IN A **PERMANENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "D" ON PAGES 139 & 140 DATED JANUARY 3-8, 1883 ORDERED BY GEORGE W. DeCAMP TO SURVEY SECTIONS 2, 3 & 4 IN TOWNSHIP 16, RANGE 11, SAID THAT **HE SET A STONE** FOR THE PERMANENT NORTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 4-16-11 ON THE 3RD STANDARD PARALLEL AT 40.00 CHAINS WEST OF THE STONE THAT HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT NORTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 3-16-11 ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**.

HIS SURVEY NOTES SHOW THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- 1) 40.00 CHAINS EAST ON THE 3RD STANDARD PARALLEL TO THE STONE HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT NORTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 3-16-11
- 2) 79.64-1/2 CHAINS EAST ON THE 3RD STANDARD PARALLEL TO THE STONE HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT NORTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 3-16-11
- 3) 99.46-3/4 CHAINS EAST ON THE 3RD STANDARD PARALLEL TO THE STONE HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT NORTH 1/8TH CORNER OF THE NE1/4 OF SEC. 3-16-11
- 4) 119.29 CHAINS EAST ON THE 3RD STANDARD PARALLEL TO THE STONE HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT NORTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 3-16-11
- 5) 159.93-1/2 CHAINS EAST ON THE 3RD STANDARD PARALLEL TO THE STONE HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT NORTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 2-16-11
- 6) 178.75-3/4 CHAINS EAST ON THE 3RD STANDARD PARALLEL TO THE STONE HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT NORTH 1/8TH CORNER OF THE NE1/4 OF SEC. 2-19-11
- 7) 198.58 CHAINS EAST ON THE 3RD STANDARD PARALLEL TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 2-16-11
- 8) 21.20 CHAINS SOUTH TO THE STONE HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT WEST 1/8TH CORNER OF THE NE1/4 OF SECTION 4-16-11
- 9) 41.20 CHAINS SOUTH TO THE STONE HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 4-16-11
- 10) 81.20 CHAINS SOUTH TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE SOUTH 1/4 CORNER SECTION 4-16-11

- 2) **COMMISSIONER'S ROAD JOURNAL BOOK "B", PAGE 15**

ON MARCH 28, 1942 A PETITION SIGNED BY EARL C. FLEMING AND OTHERS FOR THE **VACATION** OF TWO (2) ROADS IN TOWNSHIP 16-11 WAS PRESENTED TO TED NEWCOMER, COUNTY CLERK. THE ROAD WAS VIEWED BY THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS AND O. D. HENRY, COUNTY ENGINEER, ON APRIL 23, 1942 AND THE FINAL ORDER OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS ON MAY 6, 1942 **VACATED** THE FOLLOWING ROAD:

- 1) **FIRST ROAD:** BEGINNING AT THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 3-16-11 AND RUNNING WEST ONE AND ONE-HALF (1-1/2) MILES AND ENDING THERE.
- 2) THIS ROAD HAS NOT BEEN USED FOR A PUBLIC TRAVEL FOR YEARS, AND ITS PRESENT CONDITION DOES NOT LEND ITSELF TO SAFE TRAVEL. THERE SEEMS TO BE NO DEMAND FOR AN EXPENDITURE OF MONEY SUFFICIENT TO PUT THE ROADS DESCRIBED IN THE PETITION IN A SAFE TRAVELABLE CONDITION.
- 3) UPON THIS REASONS WE HAVE MADE OUR CONCLUSIONS THAT THE ROADS SHOULD BE VACATED.

ON SEPTEMBER 30, 1950 A PETITION SIGNED BY ANNA P. MOLE AND OTHERS FOR THE **VACATION** OF A ROAD IN TOWNSHIP 16-11 WAS PRESENTED TO GEORGE K. JACKSON, COUNTY CLERK. THE ROAD WAS VIEWED BY THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS AND R. W. BALL, COUNTY ENGINEER, ON OCTOBER 20, 1950 AND THE FINAL ORDER OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS ON NOVEMBER 19, 1950 **VACATED** THE FOLLOWING ROAD:

- 1) BEGINNING AT THE QUARTER CORNER ON THE NORTH LINE OF SECTION 4-16-11 AND RUNNING THENCE WEST TO WITHIN 20 FEET OF THE 1/8 LINE ON THE NORTH LINE OF SECTION 5-16-11 AND A DISTANCE OF 3/4 MILES
