

**NORTHWEST CORNER SECTION 04, TOWNSHIP 16 SOUTH, RANGE 11 EAST**

- 1) ON PAGE 299 OF THE GLO ORIGINAL FIELD NOTES IN THE DRAFTING ROOM IN THE COUNTY ENGINEER'S OFFICE IT STATES THAT **THEY SET A LIMESTONE 17" X 10" X 4"** FOR THE CORNER TO SECTIONS 4 & 5-16-11 ON THE 3<sup>RD</sup> STANDARD PARALLEL AT 7 CHAINS & 9 LINKS WEST OF THE CORNER TO SECTIONS 32 & 33 OF TOWNSHIP 15 SOUTH, RANGE 11 EAST ON JANUARY 12, 1857.

THE GOVERNMENT SURVEY NOTES SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- 1) 41.30 CHAINS SOUTH TO THE 20" X 15" X 2" LIMESTONE THEY SET FOR THE 1/4 CORNER BETWEEN SECTIONS 4 & 5-16-11
  - 2) 81.30 CHAINS SOUTH TO THE 24" X 6" X 6" LIMESTONE THEY SET FOR THE CORNER TO SECTIONS 4, 5, 8 & 9-16-11
- 2) R. H. EDMISTON, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1884 TO 1887, IN SURVEY NUMBER 141, A ROAD SURVEY RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "E" ON PAGE 141 FOR TWO ROADS IN TOWNSHIPS 15-11 AND 16-11 FOR MANLY B. SMITH, PRINCIPAL PETITIONER, DATED SEPTEMBER 9 & 10, 1886, APPARENTLY **HE FOUND THE STONE** AT THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 4-16-11 ON THE 3<sup>RD</sup> STANDARD PARALLEL TO BEGIN ROAD NUMBER 2 ON THIS ROAD SURVEY

HIS FIELD NOTES AND PLAT SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- 1) ROAD NUMBER 2: BEGINNING AT THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 6, TOWNSHIP 16, RANGE 11, I RAN EAST ON THE 3<sup>RD</sup> STANDARD PARALLEL TO THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 4, SAME TOWNSHIP AND RANGE, AT THE TERMINUS OF ROAD NUMBER 2.
- 3) R. H. EDMISTON, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1884 TO 1887, IN A ROAD SURVEY FOR ROAD NUMBER 339 RECORDED IN ROAD RECORD BOOK "C" ON PAGES 306 TO 308 [PACKET 568 IN THE VAULT IN THE COUNTY SURVEYOR'S OFFICE] PETITION BY MANLY B. SMITH AND OTHERS FOR THE VACATION OF PART OF THE SANTA FE TRAIL ROAD AND THE LOCATION OF A ROAD ON THE 3<sup>RD</sup> STANDARD PARALLEL BETWEEN TOWNSHIPS 15-11 AND 16-11 THAT HE SURVEYED ON SEPTEMBER 9, 1886, WAS ESTABLISHED ON OCTOBER 14, 1886 BY T. E. McMILLAN, CHAIRMAN OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, AND RECORDED ON MARCH 9, 1887 BY ROLAND LAKIN, COUNTY CLERK, SAID THAT **HE FOUND THE STONE** AT THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 4-16-11 ON THE 3<sup>RD</sup> STANDARD PARALLEL ON THIS ROAD SURVEY ON THE 3<sup>RD</sup> STANDARD PARALLEL. A NOTE ON THE PACKET COVER SAID TO SEE COMMISSIONERS JOURNAL VOLUME 4 ONA PAGES 376 AND 377.

HIS FIELD NOTES AND PLAT SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- 1) THE ROAD LOCATED: BEGINNING AT THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 6, TOWNSHIP 16, RANGE 11 ON THE 3<sup>RD</sup> STANDARD PARALLEL (SOUTH) TO THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 4, SAME TOWNSHIP AND RANGE TO THE TERMINUS OF THE ROAD LOCATED ON THIS ROAD SURVEY.
- 2) THE ROAD VACATED: ON THE SANTA FE TRAIL ROAD FROM THE WEST LINE OF SECTION 6 TO WHERE IT CROSSES THE EAST LINE OF SECTION 4, SAME TOWNSHIP AND RANGE AS ABOVE.
- 3) THE VIEWERS REPORTED IN FAVOR OF LOCATING SAID ROAD AS IT IS NEEDED AND LEFT OPEN BY PARTIES OWNING LAND ALONG THE LINE OF THE ROAD. THEY REPORTED IN FAVOR OF VACATING THE OLD SANTA FE TRAIL ROAD AS IT IS NOT TRAVELED MUCH , CUTS LAND, AND IS NOT SO GOOD A ROUTE.
- 4) THE VIEWERS DETERMINED THAT IF SAID ROAD BE GRANTED THAT ITS WIDTH SHALL BE SIXTY (60) FEET.
- 5) THE VIEWERS REPORT ON THE LOCATION AND VACATION WAS ACCEPTED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS ON OCTOBER 14, 1886.

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4) COMMISSIONER'S ROAD JOURNAL BOOK "B", PAGE 65 IN THE COUNTY CLERK'S OFFICE:

ON SEPTEMBER 30, 1950 A PETITION SIGNED BY ANNA P. MOLE AND OTHERS FOR THE VACATION OF A ROAD IN TOWNSHIP 16-11 WAS PRESENTED TO GEORGE K. JACKSON, COUNTY CLERK. THE ROAD WAS VIEWED BY THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS AND R. W. BALL, COUNTY ENGINEER, ON OCTOBER 20, 1950 AND THE FINAL ORDER OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS ON NOVEMBER 19, 1950 VACATED THE FOLLOWING ROAD:

- 1) BEGINNING AT THE QUARTER CORNER ON THE NORTH LINE OF SECTION 4, TOWNSHIP 16 SOUTH, RANGE 11 EAST OF THE 6<sup>TH</sup> P.M. AND RUNNING THENCE WEST TO WITHIN 20 FEET OF THE 1/8 LINE ON THE NORTH LINE OF SECTION 5-16-11 AND A DISTANCE OF 3/4 MILES.
- 2) THE VIEWERS RECOMMENDED THAT THE ROAD BE VACATED BEGINNING AT THE QUARTER CORNER ON THE NORTH LINE OF SECTION 4, TOWNSHIP 16 SOUTH, RANGE 11 EAST OF THE 6<sup>TH</sup> P.M. AND RUNNING THENCE WEST TO WITHIN 20 FEET OF THE 1/8<sup>TH</sup> LINE ON THE NORTH LINE OF SECTION 5, TOWNSHIP 16, RANGE 11 AND A DISTANCE OF 3/4 MILES.
- 3) THE TOWNSHIP TRUSTEE WAS DIRECTED TO CAUSE THE ROAD TO BE VACATED FOR PUBLIC TRAVEL.

5) AARON C. DAVIS, P.S. 1368, IN A LAND SURVEY REFERENCE REPORT DATED DECEMBER 18, 2015 FOR PROJECT NUMBER 15132-02, THE SURVEY OF A TRACT OF LAND IN THE SOUTH HALF OF SECTION 5-16-11 FOR JOHN WHITE, SURVEY F05001 IN THE SURVEY FILE FOR TOWNSHIP 16-11, SAID THAT HE SEARCHED FOR THE STONE OF RECORD AT THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 5-16-11 ON THE 3<sup>RD</sup> STANDARD PARALLEL, BUT HE DID NOT FIND THE STONE. HE DEEMED THAT THIS CORNER WAS BOTH LOST AND OBLITERATED. HE RESET THIS CORNER OF THE 3<sup>RD</sup> STANDARD PARALLEL ON LINE BETWEEN THE SOUTH 1/CORNER AND THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 32-15-11 FOR NORTH-SOUTH POSITION, AND IN LINE WITH A FENCE TO THE SOUTH FOR EAST-WEST POSITION. HE SET A 5/8" X 24" IRON BAR WITH A LYON COUNTY CAP FOR THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 5-16-11 ON THE 3<sup>RD</sup> STANDARD PARALLEL. HE NOTED ON HIS SURVEY DRAWING THAT THIS CORNER IS ALSO THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF GOVERNMENT LOT 1.

HIS SURVEY DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- 1) 409.12' EAST ON THE 3<sup>RD</sup> STANDARD PARALLEL TO THE 1/2" X 24" REBAR WITH HIS "PS 1368" CAP HE SET FOR THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF THE SE1/4 OF SECTION 32-15-11
- 2) 1,567.46' WEST ON THE 3<sup>RD</sup> STANDARD PARALLEL TO THE 1/2" X 24" REBAR WITH HIS "PS 1368" CAP HE SET FOR THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF GOVERNMENT LOT 6 ON THE SOUTH LINE OF SECTION 32-15-11
- 3) 2,232.17' WEST ON THE 3<sup>RD</sup> STANDARD PARALLEL TO THE GLO STONE HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF THE SW1/4 OF SECTION 32-15-11
- 4) 4,877.33' WEST ON THE 3<sup>RD</sup> STANDARD PARALLEL TO THE 1/2" X 24" REBAR WITH HIS "PS 1368" CAP HE SET FOR THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF THE SW1/4 OF SECTION 32-15-11
- 5) 2,772.79' SOUTH TO THE 1/2" X 24" REBAR WITH HIS "PS 1368" CAP HE SET FOR THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF GOVERNMENT LOT 3 [EAST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 5-16-11]
- 6) 4,044.27' SOUTH TO THE 1/2" X 24" REBAR WITH HIS "PS 1368" CAP HE SET FOR THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF GOVERNMENT LOT 4 ON THE EAST LINE OF SECTION 5-16-11
- 7) 5,407.27' SOUTH TO THE 5/8" X 24" REBAR WITH A LYON COUNTY CAP HE SET FOR THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 5-16-11 AND THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF GOVERNMENT LOT 4
