HIS SURVEY NOTES/DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:
  - 1) 19.82-1/2 CHAINS WEST TO THE STAKE HE SET FOR THE NORTH 1/8<sup>TH</sup> CORNER OF THE SW1/4 OF SECTION 5-16-11
  - 2) 39.65 CHAINS WEST TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 5-16-11
