

**NORTH 1/6TH CORNER NORTHWEST QUARTER OF SECTION 05, TOWNSHIP 16 SOUTH,  
RANGE 11 EAST**

- 1) R. H. EDMISTON, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1884 TO 1887, IN A ROAD SURVEY FOR ROAD 338 RECORDED IN ROAD RECORD BOOK "C" ON PAGES 302 TO 304 PETITIONED BY MANLEY B. SMITH AND OTHERS FOR THE LOCATION OF A COUNTY ROAD IN TOWNSHIPS 15-11 AND 16-11 [PACKET 568 IN THE VAULT IN THE COUNTY SURVEYOR'S OFFICE] THAT HE SURVEYED ON SEPTEMBER 9, 1886, WAS ESTABLISHED AS A 50 FOOT WIDE ROAD FROM THE PLACE OF BEGINNING TO THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 30-15-11 **ONLY** ON OCTOBER 14, 1886 BY T. E. McMILLAN, CHAIRMAN OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, AND RECORDED ON MARCH 9, 1887 BY ROLAND LAKIN, COUNTY CLERK, APPARENTLY **FOUND THE STONE** AT THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF THE WEST 1/2 OF THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 5-16-11 ON THE 3<sup>RD</sup> STANDARD PARALLEL ON THIS ROAD SURVEY.

**HIS SURVEY NOTES SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:**

- 1) THIS ROAD EXTENDS SOUTH ON THE CENTER OF THE W1/2 OF SECTION 5-16-11 TO THE NORTH END OF THE ROAD RUNNING THROUGH THE CENTER OF THE W1/2 OF SECTION 5-16-11 TO THE PLACE IT INTERSECTS THE SANTA FE TRAIL ROAD TO BEGIN THIS ROAD SURVEY
- 2) THIS ROAD EXTENDS WEST ON THE 3<sup>RD</sup> STANDARD PARALLEL TO THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 31-15-11, THEN EXTENDS NORTH ON THE SECTION LINES TO THE STONE HE FOUND A THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 30-15-11 TO END THE ROAD APPROVED ON THIS ROAD SURVEY
- 3) THE ROAD PETITIONED FROM THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 30-15-11 EXTENDING NORTH ON THE SECTION LINES FOR 1 MILE TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 19-15-11 ON THE LYON AND WABAUNSEE COUNTY LINE WAS **REJECTED** BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS
