

**WEST 1/6TH CORNER SOUTHEAST QUARTER OF SECTION 05, TOWNSHIP 16 SOUTH,
RANGE 11 EAST**

- 1) R. H. EDMISTON, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1884 TO 1887, BY MATTHEW BROWN, DEPUTY COUNTY SURVEYOR, IN A **PERMANENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "F" ON PAGE 100 AND DATED JUNE 1886, SAID THAT **HE SET A STONE 24" X 12" X 5" MARKED "1/8"** FOR THE PERMANENT WEST 1/8TH CORNER OF THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 6-16-11 ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**.

HIS SURVEY NOTES SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- 1) 20.00 CHAINS SOUTH TO THE STONE AT THE NORTH 1/4 CORNER OF SEC. 8-16-11
- 2) STEVEN S. BROSEMER, L.S. 752, DEPUTY COUNTY SURVEYOR, IN A LAND SURVEY REFERENCE REPORT DATED SEPTEMBER 09, 2003, FOR PROJECT NUMBER 03231-02, SURVEY F08001 IN THE SURVEY FILE FOR TOWNSHIP 16-11 FOR A SURVEY OF THE WEST LINE OF THE EAST 1/2 OF THE NORTHWEST 1/4 AND THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 8-16-11 FOR THE LYON COUNTY ROAD & BRIDGE DEPARTMENT [LYON COUNTY PROJECT 03-CN], SAID THAT **HE FOUND A 14" X 9" X 2" STONE MARKED "1/8"** AT THE EAST 1/16TH CORNER OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 5-16-11 WITH THE AID OF MR. WHITE, LANDOWNER, WHO WALKED HIM INTO THE FIELD AND SHOWED HIM THE STONE. MR. WHITE STATED THAT HIS FATHER HAD SAID THAT IT WAS A CORNERSTONE, AND IT WAS MARKED AS PER MATTHEW BROWN'S PERMANENT SURVEY RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "F" ON PAGE 100 IN THE OFFICE OF THE COUNTY ENGINEER, AND RECORDED IN THE OFFICE OF THE REGISTER OF DEEDS. HE SAID THAT THIS STONE WAS NOT TIED INTO THE TRAVERSE FOR THIS SURVEY.
- 1) 1/2" X 24" REBAR WITH HIS CAP SET ON THE WEST SIDE OF THE STONE
- 2) 4.0' SOUTH TO A FENCE EAST-WEST
- 3) NO OTHER REFERENCES AVAILABLE

DAVIS, P.S. 1368, IN A LAND SURVEY REFERENCE REPORT DATED DECEMBER 18, 2015 FOR PROJECT NUMBER 15132-02, THE SURVEY OF A TRACT OF LAND IN THE SOUTH HALF OF SECTION 5-16-11 FOR JOHN WHITE, SURVEY F05001 IN THE SURVEY FILE FOR TOWNSHIP 16-11, SAID THAT **HE FOUND THE EXISTING RECORD 12" X 5" LIMESTONE WITH A 5/8" REBAR WITH A LYON COUNTY CAP AT THE EAST FACE OF THE STONE** AT THE EAST 1/16TH CORNER OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 5-19-11 SET BY MATTHEW BROWN, DEPUTY COUNTY SURVEYOR, IN 1886 AND RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "F" ON PAGE 100 IN THE LYON COUNTY ENGINEERS OFFICE.

- 1) 13.25' SW TO A 40 D NAIL & BOTTLECAP IN A STEEL FENCE POST
- 2) 5.60' SE TO A 40 D NAIL & BOTTLECAP IN A STEEL FENCE POST
- 3) 19.90' ESE TO A 40 D NAIL & BOTTLECAP IN A STEEL FENCE POST
- 4) 3.50' SOUTH TO A LINE OF FENCE RUNNING EAST AND WEST

HIS SURVEY DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- 1) 1,318.92' WEST TO THE 1/2" X 24" REBAR WITH HIS "PS 1368" CAP HE SET FOR THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF THE SE1/4 OF THE SW1/4 OF SECTION 5-16-11, AS WITNESSED BY THE 1/2" X 24" REBAR WITH HIS "PS 1368" CAP HE SET AT 20' EAST ON THE EAST RIGHT-OF-WAY LINE OF COUNTY ROAD H2
- 2) 2,637.84' WEST TO THE 1/2" X 24" REBAR WITH HIS "PS 1368" CAP HE SET FOR THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF THE SW1/4 OF THE SW1/4 OF SECTION 15-16-11
- 3) 1,024.64' EAST TO THE STONE SET BY BROWN HE FOUND AT THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF GOVERNMENT LOT 5 ON THE EAST BOUNDARY OF THE KANSAS RESERVE
- 4) 2,591.63' EAST TO THE 1/2" X 24" REBAR WITH HIS "PS 1368" CAP HE SET FOR THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF GOVERNMENT LOT 4 ON THE EAST LINE OF THE SE1/4 OF SECTION 5-16-11
