

WEST 1/4 CORNER SECTION 06, TOWNSHIP 16 SOUTH, RANGE 11 EAST

- 1) ON PAGE 58 OF THE GLO ORIGINAL FIELD NOTES IN THE DRAFTING ROOM IN THE COUNTY ENGINEER'S OFFICE IT STATES THAT **THEY SET A LIMESTONE 30" X 10" X 3"** FOR THE WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 6-16-11 ON THE WEST TOWNSHIP BOUNDARY.

THE GOVERNMENT SURVEY NOTES SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- 1) 39.94 CHAINS NORTH ON THE WEST TOWNSHIP BOUNDARY TO THE 24" X 6" X 5" LIMESTONE THEY SET FOR THE CLOSING CORNER TO SECTION 6-16-11 ON THE 3RD STANDARD PARALLEL
 - 2) 40.00 CHAINS SOUTH ON THE TOWNSHIP BOUNDARY TO THE 18" X 12" X 3" LIMESTONE THEY SET FOR THE CORNER TO SECTIONS 6 & 7-16-11
- 2) C. H. RICE, DEPUTY COUNTY SURVEYOR, IN AN **INFORMAL SURVEY** RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "D" ON PAGE 154 AND DATED APRIL 25, 1883 AT THE REQUEST OF McFALL TO SURVEY SECTION 1-16-10, APPARENTLY DID **NOT** FIND THE STONE AT THE EAST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 1-16-10 ON THE RANGE LINE AS HE RAN THE RANGE LINE FROM THE STONE THAT HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 1-16-10 TO THE STONE THAT HE FOUND AT THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 1-16-10 ON THIS **INFORMAL SURVEY**.
- 3) R. H. EDMISTON, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1884 TO 1887, IN SURVEY NUMBER 121, A **PERMANENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "E" ON PAGE 121 DATED SEPTEMBER 14 & 15, 1885 ORDERED BY SAMUEL RALY TO SURVEY AND LOCATE THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 1-16-10, SAID THAT **FOUND THE STONE** AT THE EAST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 1-16-10 ON THE RANGE LINE ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**.
HIS SURVEY NOTES/DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:
 - 1) 1,320' NORTH ON THE RANGE LINE TO THE TEMPORARY STAKE HE SET FOR THE EAST 1/8TH CORNER OF THE NE1/4 OF SECTION 1-16-10
 - 2) 2,666' NORTH ON THE RANGE LINE TO THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 1-16-10 ON THE 3RD STANDARD PARALLEL – NOT IDENTIFIED AS A STONE ON HIS SURVEY DRAWING
 - 3) 2,632' SOUTH ON THE RANGE LINE TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 1-16-10
