

**NORTH 1/6TH CORNER SOUTHEAST QUARTER OF SECTION 07, TOWNSHIP 16 SOUTH,
RANGE 11 EAST**

EDMISTON, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1884 TO 1887, BY MATTHEW BROWN, DEPUTY COUNTY SURVEYOR, IN SURVEY NUMBER 77 RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "F" ON PAGES 100 TO 103 DATED APRIL 26 THROUGH JUNE 22, 1886, TO SUBDIVIDE SECTIONS 7, 8, 17 & 18 AND THE SOUTH 1/2 OF SECTION 5, ALL IN TOWNSHIP 16, RANGE 10, SAID THAT **HE SET A 16" X 12" X 3" STONE MARKED "1/8" ON THE SOUTH FACE** FOR THE NORTH 1/8TH CORNER OF THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 7-16-11 ON THIS SURVEY.

HIS SURVEY NOTES/DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- 1) 20.00 CHAINS EAST TO THE STAKE HE SET FOR THE EAST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 7-16-11
- 2) 40.00 CHAINS WEST TO THE 20" X 15" X 2" STONE MARKED "1/8" ON THE SOUTH FACE HE SET FOR THE NORTH 1/8TH CORNER OF THE SW1/4 OF SECTION 7-16-11
- 3) 57.74 CHAINS WEST TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 7-16-11 IN THE RANGE LINE
