EDMISTON, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1884 TO 1887, BY MATTHEW BROWN, DEPUTY COUNTY SURVEYOR, IN SURVEY NUMBER 77 RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "F" ON PAGES 100 TO 103 DATED APRIL 26 THROUGH JUNE 22, 1886, TO SUBDIVIDE SECTIONS 7, 8, 17 & 18 AND THE SOUTH 1/2 OF SECTION 5, ALL IN TOWNSHIP 16, RANGE 11, SAID THAT **HE SET A 20" X 15" X 2" STONE MARKED "1/8" ON THE SOUTH FACE** FOR THE NORTH 1/8TH CORNER OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 7-16-11 ON THIS SURVEY.

HIS SURVEY NOTES/DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- 1) 17.74 CHAINS WEST TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 7-16-11 ON THE RANGE LINE
- 2) 40.00 CHAINS EAST TO THE 16" X 12" X 3" STONE MARKED "1/8" ON THE SOUTH FACE HE SET FOR THE NORTH 1/8TH CORNER OF THE SE1/4 OF SECTION 7-16-11
- 3) 60.00 CHAINS EAST TO THE STAKE HE SET FOR THE EAST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 7-16-11
