EDMISTON, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1884 TO 1887, BY MATTHEW BROWN, DEPUTY COUNTY SURVEYOR, IN SURVEY NUMBER 77 RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "F" ON PAGES 100 TO 103 DATED APRIL 26 THROUGH JUNE 22, 1886, TO SUBDIVIDE SECTIONS 7, 8, 17 & 18 AND THE SOUTH 1/2 OF SECTION 5, ALL IN TOWNSHIP 16, RANGE 10, SAID THAT **HE SET A 20" X 12" X 4" STONE MARKED WITH A PLUS ("+") ON THE TOP AND A PLUS ("+") NEAR THE BOTTOM ON THE WEST FACE** FOR THE CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 8-16-11 ON THIS SURVEY.
HIS SURVEY NOTES/DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:
 - 1) 19.87 CHAINS SOUTH TO THE 19" X 7" X 5" STONE MARKED "1/8" ON THE WEST FACE HE SET FOR THE EAST 1/8TH CORNER OF THE SW1/4 OF SECTION 8-16-11
 - 2) 39.74 CHAINS SOUTH TO THE STAKE HE SET FOR THE SOUTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 8-16-11

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
