EDMISTON, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1884 TO 1887, BY MATTHEW BROWN, DEPUTY COUNTY SURVEYOR, IN SURVEY NUMBER 77 RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "F" ON PAGES 100 TO 103 DATED APRIL 26 THROUGH JUNE 22, 1886, TO SUBDIVIDE SECTIONS 7, 8, 17 & 18 AND THE SOUTH 1/2 OF SECTION 5, ALL IN TOWNSHIP 16, RANGE 10, SAID THAT **HE SET A 13" X 8" X 6" STONE MARKED "1/4 RL" ON THE WEST FACE** ON THE KANSAS INDIAN RESERVATION LINE FOR THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF GOVERNMENT LOT 6 IN THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 8-16-11. SEE THE NOTE ON PAGE 101 ON COMMENTS THAT HE RECEIVED A "STATEMENT FROM THE DEPARTMENT OF THE INTERIOR THAT THE BOUNDARY LINES OF THE KANSAS INDIAN RESERVATION WERE STRAIGHT LINES". HE COMMENTED IN HIS NOTES: "THE STONES ON THIS INDIAN LINE ARE NOT GOVERNMENT BY MEASUREMENTS EAST OR WEST BUT ARE SET ON TRUE LINE AND SET AT RIGHT ANGLES FROM THE STONES ON THE NORTH AND SOUTH LINES OF THE EAST SIDE OF THEIR RESPECTIVE SECTIONS."
