

**NORTH 1/6TH CORNER NORTHWEST QUARTER OF SECTION 15, TOWNSHIP 16 SOUTH,
RANGE 11 EAST**

- 1) STEVEN S. BROSEMER, L.S. 752, DEPUTY COUNTY SURVEYOR, IN A LAND SURVEY REFERENCE REPORT DATED OCTOBER 25, 2005, FOR PROJECT NUMBER 05289-02, SURVEY F10001 IN THE SURVEY FILE FOR TOWNSHIP 16-11 TO SURVEY THE SOUTH 1/2 OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 10-16-11 FOR JACKIE WALL, SAID THAT HE DETERMINED A **THEORETICAL POSITION** FOR THE SOUTH 1/16TH CORNER OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 10-16-11 TO BE ON LINE AND HALFWAY BETWEEN THE RAILROAD SPIKE THAT HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 10-16-11 AND THE 1/2" REBAR THAT HE FOUND AT THE SOUTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 10-16-11, BUT THE POSITION WAS **NOT** MONUMENTED ON THIS SURVEY.

HIS SURVEY DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- 1) 1,332.39' WEST TO THE RAILROAD SPIKE HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF THE SW1/4 OF SECTION 10-16-11
- 2) 1,332.39' EAST TO THE 1/2" REBAR HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF THE SW1/4 OF SECTION 10-16-11
- 3) 25.00' NORTH TO THE 1/2" REBAR WITH HIS "LS 752" CAP HE SET FOR A RIGHT-OF-WAY CORNER [**HORIZONTAL TIE**]
