

**NORTH 1/6TH CORNER NORTHEAST QUARTER OF SECTION 19, TOWNSHIP 16 SOUTH,
RANGE 11 EAST**

- 1) J. H. HIBBEN, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1875 TO 1882, BY FRANK P. MACLEMAN, DEPUTY COUNTY SURVEYOR, IN A **PERMANENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "C" ON PAGE 208 DATED MAY 7-9, 1878 ORDERED BY J. K. PETERMAN AND HENRY HAAS TO SUBDIVIDE THE NORTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 19-16-11 AND THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 20-16-11, SAID THAT **HE SET A STONE** FOR THE PERMANENT NORTHWEST CORNER OF THE NORTHEAST 1/4 OF THE NORTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 19-16-11 ON LINE AND AT THE MIDDLE POINT BETWEEN THE STONE THAT HE FOUND AT THE NORTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 19-16-11 AND THE STONE THAT HE FOUND AT THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 19-16-11 ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**.

HIS SURVEY NOTES/DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- 1) 76 RODS, 10-1/2 LINKS WEST TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE 1/4 CORNER ON THE NORTH LINE OF SECTION 19-16-11
- 2) 76 RODS, 10-1/2 LINKS EAST TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 19-16-11
- 3) 161 RODS, 23 LINKS SOUTH TO THE STONE HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT SOUTHEAST CORNER OF THE SE1/4 OF THE NE1/4 OF SECTION 19-16-11
