

**NORTH 1/6TH CORNER SOUTHWEST QUARTER OF SECTION 20, TOWNSHIP 16 SOUTH,
RANGE 11 EAST**

- 1) J. H. HIBBEN, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1875 TO 1882, BY FRANK P. MACLEMAN, DEPUTY COUNTY SURVEYOR, IN A **PERMANENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "C" ON PAGE 208 DATED MAY 7-9, 1878 ORDERED BY J. K. PETERMAN AND HENRY HAAS TO SUBDIVIDE THE NORTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 19-16-11 AND THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 20-16-11, SAID THAT **HE SET A STONE** FOR THE PERMANENT SOUTHEAST CORNER OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 20-16-11 ON LINE AND AT THE MIDWAY POINT BETWEEN THE STONE THAT HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT EAST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 19-16-11 AND THE STONE THAT HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 20-16-11 ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**.

HIS SURVEY NOTES/DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- 1) 79 RODS, 13 LINKS WEST TO THE STONE HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT EAST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 19-16-11
- 2) 79 RODS, 13 LINKS EAST TO THE STONE HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 20-16-11
- 3) 162 RODS, 2-1/2 LINKS NORTH TO THE STONE HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT NORTHEAST CORNER OF THE NW1/4 OF THE NW1/4 OF SECTION 20-16-11

- 2) J. H. HIBBEN, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1875 TO 1882, IN A ROAD SURVEY FOR ROAD NUMBER 79 RECORDED IN ROAD RECORD BOOK "A-1" ON PAGES 318 TO 320 PETITIONED BY JOHN T. HYDE AND OTHERS FOR TWO COUNTY ROADS IN TOWNSHIP 16-11 [PACKET 223 IN THE VAULT IN THE COUNTY SURVEYOR'S OFFICE] THAT HE SURVEYED ON SEPTEMBER 15, 1880, WAS ESTABLISHED AS 40 FOOT WIDE EAST-WEST ROADS AND 60 FOOT WIDE NORTH-SOUTH ROADS ON OCTOBER 5, 1880, AND WAS RECORDED ON OCTOBER 12, 1880 BY WILLIAM F. EWING, COUNTY CLERK, SAID THAT **HE FOUND THE STONE** AT THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF THE WEST 1/2 OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 8-16-11 ON THE FIRST ROAD OF THIS ROAD SURVEY.

HIS SURVEY NOTES SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- 1) THE FIRST ROAD EXTENDS NORTH ON THE 1/2/4 LINE TO INTERSECT THE SANTA FE ROAD FOR THE TERMINUS OF THE FIRST ROAD ON THIS ROAD SURVEY
- 2) THE FIRST ROAD EXTENDS WEST ON THE 1/2 SECTION LINE TO THE EAST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 19-16-11; THEN CONTINUES SOUTH ON THE SECTION LINES TO THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 19-16-11 TO COMMENCE THE FIRST ROAD ON THIS ROAD SURVEY

- 3) J. H. HIBBEN, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1875 TO 1882, IN A ROAD SURVEY RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "C" ON THE RIGHT SIDE PAGE 189 DATED SEPTEMBER 15, 1880, FOR A COUNTY ROAD IN TOWNSHIP 16-11, APPARENTLY **FOUND THE STONE** AT THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF THE WEST 1/2 OF THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 20-19-11 ON THIS ROAD SURVEY.

HIS SURVEY NOTES SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- 1) THIS ROAD EXTENDS WEST FOR 1,320' TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 20-16-11 AT A TURN TO THE SOUTH TO THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 19-16-11 FOR THE TERMINUS OF THIS ROAD SURVEY
- 2) THIS ROAD EXTENDS NORTH ON THE 1/2/4 SECTION LINE TO INTERSECT THE SANTA FE ROAD IN THE WEST 1/2 OF THE NW1/4 OF SECTION 5-19-11
