

**SOUTHEAST CORNER OF ALLEN TOWNSITE IN NORTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 23,
TOWNSHIP 16 SOUTH, RANGE 11 EAST**

- 1) ALVA J. SMITH, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1900 THROUGH 1906, IN SURVEY NUMBER 71, A **PERMANENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "F" ON PAGE 150 DATED MARCH 24 & 25, 1903 AT THE REQUEST OF W. C. SKAGGS AND OTHERS FOR A SURVEY FOR THE PURPOSE OF LOCATING AND PERMANENTLY ESTABLISHING THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 15 AND THE CORNERS AND BOUNDARIES OF THE SUBDIVISION OF THE EAST 1/2 OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 14, AND THE WEST 1/2 OF THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 15, ALL IN TOWNSHIP 16 SOUTH, RANGE 11 EAST, AND TO RUN SUCH LINES AS MAY BE NECESSARY TO COMPLETE THE WORK, SAID THAT HE RAN THE SECTION LINES FROM THE ORIGINAL GOVERNMENT STONE THAT HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 14 TO THE STONE THAT HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 16 ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**. **HE SET A 16" X 8" X 3" STONE 15 FEET NORTH OF A FENCE ON THE EAST LINE OF RUST STREET AND 15 FEET NORTH OF THE FENCE ON THE SOUTH SIDE OF THE ROAD** FOR THE PERMANENT SOUTHEAST CORNER OF ALLEN TOWNSITE IN THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 14-16-11 ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**. HIS FIELD NOTES ARE IN BOOK 3 ON PAGES 117-128 IN THE "KRETSINGER COLLECTION" OF FIELD BOOKS, AND THERE IS ADDITIONAL INFORMATION IN PACKET "M 159" IN MISCELLANEOUS DRAWER NUMBER 8 IN THE VAULT IN THE COUNTY ENGINEER'S OFFICE.

HIS SURVEY NOTES/DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- 1) 1,490-1/2' WEST TO THE 24" X 8" X 2' STONE HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT SOUTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 15-16-11
 - 2) 2,921-1/2' WEST TO THE 20" X 10" X 4" STONE HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT SOUTHWEST CORNER OF ALLEN TOWNSITE ON THE WEST LINE OF *WISER STREET*
 - 3) 4,122-1/2' WEST TO THE 14" X 8" X 4" STONE HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT SOUTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 15-16-11 AT 9 FEET WEST OF A FENCE EXTENDING NORTH AND 23 FEET NORTH OF THE FENCE ON THE SOUTH SIDE OF THE ROAD
 - 4) 6,754-1/2' WEST TO THE STAKE HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT SOUTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 15-16-11
 - 5) 12,021-1/2' WEST TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 16-16-11
 - 6) 1,178-1/2' EAST TO THE 18" X 6" X 4" STONE SET FOR THE PERMANENT SOUTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 14-16-11 ON THE EAST LINE OF THE CEMETERY AND 18 FEET NORTH OF THE FENCE ON THE SOUTH SIDE OF THE ROAD
 - 7) 3,786-1/2' EAST TO THE ORIGINAL GOVERNMENT STONE HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 14-16-11 FROM WHICH A STONE SET BY MATTHEW BROWN IN A SURVEY MADE IN 1888 STANDS 22 FEET EAST AND 5 FEET SOUTH
 - 8) 1,080' NORTH TO THE 18" X 6" X 6" STONE HE SET ON THE NORTH LINE OF THE RAILROAD RIGHT-OF-WAY
 - 9) 1,356' NORTH TO THE 14" X 8" X 4" STONE HE SET FOR THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF THE YOUNG TRACT
 - 10) 2,638' NORTH TO A 1" ROUND IRON PIN HE DROVE FOR THE PERMANENT NORTHEAST CORNER OF ALLEN TOWNSITE AT 24 FEET NORTH OF AN ASH TREE
- 2) STEVEN S. BROSEMER, L.S. 752, IN A LAND SURVEY REFERENCE REPORT DATED SEPTEMBER 15, 1983, SAID THAT HE SEARCHED FOR THE STONE THAT WAS SET BY ALVA J. SMITH IN 1903 AT THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF THE ALLEN TOWNSITE AS RECORDED IN PERMANENT SURVEY BOOK "F" ON PAGE 150 WITH A COUNTY

MAINTAINER, BUT HE DID **NOT** FIND THE STONE. HE CONCLUDED THAT THE STONE WAS **DESTROYED** BY ROAD WORK, AND HE DID **NOT** RESET THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF THE ALLEN TOWNSITE AT THIS TIME.
