- 1) ALVA J. SMITH, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1900 THROUGH 1906, IN SURVEY NUMBER 97, A **PERMANENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "F" ON PAGE 177 DATED JUNE 28, 1904 BY THE ORDER OF T. G. WISDOM FOR THE PURPOSE OF LOCATING AND PERMANENTLY ESTABLISHING THE CORNERS AND BOUNDARIES OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 24-16-11 AND RUN SUCH LINES AS MAY BE NECESSARY TO PROPERLY COMPLETE THE WORK, SAID THAT **HE SET A 16" X 8" X 5" STONE** FOR THE PERMANENT CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 24-16-11 AT THE INTERSECTION OF TRANSIT LINES FROM THE OPPOSITE 1/4 CORNERS ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**. HIS FIELD NOTES ARE IN BOOK 2 ON PAGE 60 IN THE "KRETSINGER COLLECTION" OF FIELD BOOKS, AND THERE IS ADDITIONAL INFORMATION IN PACKET "M 158" IN MISCELLANEOUS DRAWER NUMBER 8 IN THE VAULT IN THE COUNTY ENGINEER'S OFFICE.
