

NORTH 1/4 CORNER SECTION 31, TOWNSHIP 16 SOUTH, RANGE 11 EAST

- 1) ON PAGE 300 OF THE GLO ORIGINAL FIELD NOTES IN THE DRAFTING ROOM IN THE COUNTY ENGINEER'S OFFICE IT STATES THAT **THEY SET A LIMESTONE 20" X 14" X 3"** FOR THE 1/4 CORNER BETWEEN SECTIONS 30 & 31-16-11.
THE GOVERNMENT SURVEY NOTES SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:
 - 1) 35.20 CHAINS WEST TO THE 18" X 14" X 3" LIMESTONE THEY SET FOR THE CORNER TO SECTIONS 30 & 31-16-11 ON THE WEST TOWNSHIP BOUNDARY
 - 2) 40.00 CHAINS EAST TO THE 30" X 16" X 3" LIMESTONE THEY SET FOR THE CORNER TO SECTIONS 29, 30, 31 & 32

- 2) J. H. HIBBEN, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1875 TO 1882, IN A ROAD SURVEY FOR ROAD NUMBER 13 RECORDED IN ROAD RECORD BOOK "A-1" ON PAGES 50 TO 52 FOR A PETITION BY H. D. CURTIS AND OTHERS TO VACATE AND LOCATE A COUNTY ROAD IN TOWNSHIP 16-11 [PACKET 10 IN THE VAULT IN THE COUNTY SURVEYOR'S OFFICE] THAT HE SURVEYED ON NOVEMBER 11, 1878, WAS ESTABLISHED AS A 60 FOOT WIDE ROAD ON JANUARY 8, 1879, AND WAS RECORDED ON JANUARY 18, 1879 BY WILLIAM F. EWING, COUNTY CLERK, SAID THAT **HE FOUND THE STONE** AT THE NORTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 31-16-11 AT A TURN ON THIS ROAD SURVEY.
HIS SURVEY NOTES SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:
 - 1) THIS ROAD EXTENDS EAST ON THE SECTION LINE FOR 1,320' TO INTERSECT THE ROAD FROM AMERICUS TO ALLEN CREEK AT THE TERMINUS OF THIS ROAD SURVEY
 - 2) THIS ROAD EXTENDS SOUTH ON THE 1/2 SECTION LINE FOR 2,640 FEET TO THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF THE NE1/4 OF SECTION 31-16-11 TO COMMENCE THIS ROAD SURVEY

- 3) J. H. HIBBEN, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1875 TO 1882, IN A ROAD SURVEY RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "C" AT THE LEFT SIDE OF PAGE 162 DATED NOVEMBER 11, 1878, SAID THAT **HE FOUND THE STONE** AT THE NORTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 31-16-11 ON THIS ROAD SURVEY.
HIS SURVEY NOTES SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:
 - 1) THIS ROAD EXTENDS SOUTH FOR 1/2 MILE TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF THE NE1/4 OF SECTION 31-16-11 AND THE BEGINNING OF THIS ROAD SURVEY
 - 2) 1,320' EAST ON THE SECTION LINE TO INTERSECT THE AMERICUS AND ALLEN ROAD AT THE TERMINATION OF THIS ROAD SURVEY

- 4) J. H. HIBBEN, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1875 TO 1882, IN AN AGREEMENT SURVEY DATED APRIL 15, 1880 FILED IN THE REGISTER OF SEEDS OFFICE ON PAGE 553 FOR HORN R. MAYS, JESSE FOSTER, AND REBECCA M. CURTIS TO ESTABLISH THE LINE BETWEEN THE EAST 1/2 OF THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 AND THE WEST 1/2 OF THE SOUTHEAST 1/4, ALSO THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF THE WEST 1/2 OF THE SOUTHEAST 1/4, AND THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF THE WEST 1/2 OF THE SOUTHEAST 1/4, ALSO THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4, ALL IN SECTION 31-16-11, SAID THAT **HE FOUND THE STONE** AT THE NORTH 1/4 OF SECTION 31-16-11 ON THIS AGREEMENT SURVEY. THIS SURVEY IS FILED AT SURVEY F31001 IN THE SURVEY FILE FOR TOWNSHIP 16-11.

- 5) COMMISSIONERS ROAD JOURNAL BOOK "B" ON PAGE 107:
IT WAS NOTED THAT THE FOLLOWING ROAD WAS **CLOSED** UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF 68-102 OF THE GENERAL STATUTES SUPPLEMENT 1953 BY A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS DATED JULY 20, 1957:

- 1) BEGINNING AT THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF THE NORTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 31-16-11; THENCE NORTH 1/2 MILE; THENCE EAST 1/4 MILE; THENCE NORTH 1 MILE TO THE NORTH LINE OF SECTION 30-16-11 AND THERE ENDING.
