

**NORTH 1/6TH CORNER NORTHEAST QUARTER OF SECTION 31, TOWNSHIP 16 SOUTH,  
RANGE 11 EAST**

- 1) J. H. HIBBEN, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1875 TO 1882, IN A ROAD SURVEY FOR ROAD NUMBER 13 RECORDED IN ROAD RECORD BOOK "A-1" ON PAGES 50 TO 52 FOR A PETITION BY H. D. CURTIS AND OTHERS TO VACATE AND LOCATE A COUNTY ROAD IN TOWNSHIP 16-11 [PACKET 10 IN THE VAULT IN THE COUNTY SURVEYOR'S OFFICE] THAT HE SURVEYED ON NOVEMBER 11, 1878, WAS ESTABLISHED AS A 60 FOOT WIDE ROAD ON JANUARY 8, 1879, AND WAS RECORDED ON JANUARY 18, 1879 BY WILLIAM F. EWING, COUNTY CLERK, SAID THAT **HE FOUND THE STONE** AT THE NORTH 1/16<sup>TH</sup> CORNER OF THE NORTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 31-16-11 AT THE INTERSECTION OF THE AMERICUS TO ALLEN CREEK ROAD FOR THE TERMINUS OF THIS THIS ROAD SURVEY.

HIS SURVEY NOTES SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- 1) THIS ROAD EXTENDS WEST ON THE SECTION LINE FOR 1,320 FEET TO THE 1/4 CORNER ON THE NORTH LINE OF SECTION 31-16-11, THEN TURNS SOUTH ON THE 1/2 SECTION LINE FOR 2,640 FEET TO THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF THE NE1/4 OF SECTION 31-16-11 TO COMMENCE THIS ROAD SURVEY
- 2) J. H. HIBBEN, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1875 TO 1882, IN A ROAD SURVEY FOR ROAD NUMBER 52 RECORDED IN ROAD RECORD BOOK "A-1" ON PAGES 210 TO 212 PETITIONED BY A. L. SAUNDERS AND OTHERS FOR A COUNTY ROAD IN TOWNSHIP 16-11 [PACKET 129 IN THE VAULT IN THE COUNTY SURVEYOR'S OFFICE] THAT HE SURVEYED ON OCTOBER 11, 1879, WAS ESTABLISHED AS A 40 FOOT WIDE ROAD ON JANUARY 7, 1880, AND WAS RECORDED ON JANUARY 19, 1880 BY WILLIAM F. EWING, COUNTY CLERK, SAID THAT **HE FOUND THE STONE** AT 80 RODS WEST OF THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 31-16-11 TO COMMENCE THE FIRST ROAD ON THIS ROAD SURVEY.

HIS SURVEY NOTES SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- 1) THIS FIRST ROAD EXTENDS NORTH FOR 5,280' TO THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF THE W1/2 OF THE NE1/4 OF SECTION 30-16-11; THEN TURNS EAST FOR 5,351' TO INTERSECT THE AMERICUS AND ALLEN ROAD AT THE TERMINUS OF THE FIRST ROAD ON THIS ROAD SURVEY
- 2) THE FIRST ROAD EXTENDS EAST FOR 80 RODS TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 31-16-11
- 3) J. H. HIBBEN, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1875 TO 1882, IN A ROAD SURVEY RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "C" ON THE RIGHT SIDE PAGE 175 DATED OCTOBER 11, 1879, FOR A COUNTY ROAD IN TOWNSHIP 16-11, APPARENTLY **FOUND THE STONE** AT 80 RODS WEST OF THE *NORTHEAST* CORNER OF SECTION 30-16-11 TO COMMENCE THE FIRST ROAD ON THIS ROAD SURVEY. [**NOTE:** THIS SHOULD BE THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 30-16-11 AS HE RAN NORTH 5,280 FEET TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF THE WEST 1/2 OF THE NORTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 30-16-11. THIS ALSO CORRESPONDS TO HIS SURVEY DRAWING – WARREN CHIP WOODS, L.S. 603, COUNTY SURVEYOR]

HIS SURVEY NOTES SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- 1) 5,280' NORTH ON THE 1/8<sup>TH</sup> SECTION LINE TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF THE W1/2 OF THE NE1/4 OF SECTION 30-16-11
- 4) COMMISSIONERS ROAD JOURNAL BOOK "B" ON PAGE 107:  
IT WAS NOTED THAT THE FOLLOWING ROAD WAS **CLOSED** UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF 68-102 OF THE GENERAL STATUTES SUPPLEMENT 1953 BY A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS DATED JULY 20, 1957:
- 1) BEGINNING AT THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF THE NORTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 31-16-11; THENCE NORTH 1/2 MILE; THENCE EAST 1/4 MILE; THENCE NORTH 1 MILE TO THE NORTH LINE OF SECTION 30-16-11 AND THERE ENDING.

- 5) COMMISSIONERS ROAD JOURNAL BOOK "B" ON PAGE 108:  
IT WAS NOTED THAT THE FOLLOWING ROAD WAS **CLOSED** UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF 68-102 OF THE GENERAL STATUTES SUPPLEMENT 1953 BY A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS DATED JULY 20, 1957:
- 1) BEGINNING AT THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 31-16-11, THENCE WEST 1/4 OF A MILE AND THERE ENDING.
