

**CENTER CORNER SECTION 32, TOWNSHIP 16 SOUTH, RANGE 11 EAST**

- 1) ROBERT MILLIKEN, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1870 TO 1875 AND FROM 1882 TO 1883, IN A PERMANENT SURVEY RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "C" ON PAGE 63 AND DATED MARCH 1874, SAID THAT **HE SET A STONE** AT THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF THE FRACTIONAL SOUTHEAST QUARTER OF SECTION 32-16-11 ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**.
  
- 2) J. H. HIBBEN, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1875 TO 1882, IN AN **AGREEMENT SURVEY** FOR HORACE D. CURTIS, RICHARD KORKLAUS, RICHARD H. DUNCAN, AND EDWIN MOREHEAD, TO ESTABLISH THE CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 32-16-11 DATED APRIL 15 & 16, 1880, SURVEY F32001 IN THE SURVEY FILE FOR TOWNSHIP 16-11, SAID THAT **HE PLANTED A LIMESTONE 19-1/2" X 13" X 3"** FOR THE CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 32-16-11 AT THE INTERSECTION OF THE LINES FROM THE OPPOSITE 1/4 CORNERS ON THIS **AGREEMENT SURVEY**. THIS SURVEY IS FILED IN THE REGISTER OF DEEDS OFFICE.  
**HIS SURVEY NOTES/DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:**
  - 1) 16.47 CHAINS EAST TO THE 29" X 16" X 4" LIMESTONE HE PLANTED AT THE INTERSECTION OF THE INDIAN TRUST LINE FOR THE NORTHEAST CORNER FOR THE FRACTIONAL E1/2 OF THE SE1/4 OF SECTION 32-16-11
  
  - 3) REA BOOK 30 ON PAGE 19.5 SHOWS A **STONE BETWEEN FENCES EAST AND WEST** AT THE CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 32-16-11.
    - 2) 20' WEST TO A WITNESS PIN

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
