

NORTH 1/4 CORNER SECTION 32, TOWNSHIP 16 SOUTH, RANGE 11 EAST

- 1) ON PAGE 300 OF THE GLO ORIGINAL FIELD NOTES IN THE DRAFTING ROOM IN THE COUNTY ENGINEER'S OFFICE IT STATES THAT **THEY SET A LIMESTONE 16" X 12" X 10"** FOR THE 1/4 CORNER BETWEEN SECTIONS 29 & 32-16-11.
THE GOVERNMENT SURVEY NOTES SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:
 - 1) 40.00 CHAINS WEST TO THE 30" X 16" X 3" LIMESTONE THEY SET FOR THE CORNER TO SECTIONS 29, 30, 31 & 32-16-11
 - 2) 17.62 CHAINS EAST TO THE 13" X 13" X 4" LIMESTONE THEY SET ON THE EAST BOUNDARY OF THE KANSAS INDIAN RESERVATION
 - 3) 39.62 CHAINS EAST TO THE 25" X 9" X 6" LIMESTONE THEY SET FOR THE CORNER TO SECTIONS 28, 29, 32 & 33-16-11

- 2) J. H. HIBBEN, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1875 TO 1882, BY FRANK P. MACLEMAN, DEPUTY COUNTY SURVEYOR, IN A **PERMANENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "C" ON PAGE 207 DATED MAY 6-9, 1878 ORDERED BY GARRETT De BAUN AND A. L. SANDERS TO SUBDIVIDE THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 29-16-11, SAID THAT **HE FOUND THE STONE** AT THE SOUTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 29-16-11 ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**.

- 3) J. H. HIBBEN, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1875 TO 1882, IN AN **AGREEMENT SURVEY** FOR HORACE D. CURTIS, RICHARD KORKLAUS, RICHARD H. DUNCAN, AND EDWIN MOREHEAD, TO ESTABLISH THE CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 32-16-11 DATED APRIL 15 & 16, 1880, SURVEY F32001 IN THE SURVEY FILE FOR TOWNSHIP 16-11, SAID THAT **HE FOUND THE STONE** AT THE NORTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 32-16-11 ON THIS **AGREEMENT SURVEY**. THIS SURVEY IS FILED IN THE REGISTER OF DEEDS OFFICE.

- 4) J. H. HIBBEN, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1875 TO 1882, IN A ROAD SURVEY RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "C" ON THE RIGHT PAGE 193 DATED AUGUST 7, 1880, FOR A ROAD SURVEY IN TOWNSHIP 16-11 APPARENTLY **FOUND THE STONE** AT THE SOUTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 29-16-11 ON THIS ROAD SURVEY.
HIS SURVEY NOTES SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:
 - 1) THIS ROAD EXTENDS NORTH ON THE 1/2 SECTION LINE TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 29-16-11
 - 2) THIS ROAD EXTENDS SOUTH ON THE 1/2 SECTION LINE TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF THE SE1/4 OF SECTION 32-16-11 ON THE TOWNSHIP LINE

- 5) J. H. HIBBEN, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1875 TO 1882, IN A ROAD SURVEY FOR ROAD NUMBER 94 RECORDED IN ROAD RECORD BOOK "A-1" ON PAGES 378 TO 380 PETITIONED BY EDWIN MOORHEAD AND OTHERS TO LOCATE AND VACATE A ROAD IN TOWNSHIP 16-11 [PACKET 348 IN THE VAULT IN THE COUNTY SURVEYOR'S OFFICE] THAT HE SURVEYED ON NOVEMBER 26, 1880, WAS ESTABLISHED AS A 60' WIDE ROAD **EXCEPT** THAT PORTION RUNNING EAST ON THE 1/2 SECTION LINE [FROM THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 29-16-11 TO THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 27-16-11] ON JANUARY 5, 1881, AND WAS RECORDED ON JANUARY 5, 1881 BY WILLIAM F. EWING, COUNTY CLERK, SAID THAT **HE FOUND THE STONE** AT THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 29-16-11 ON THE ROAD ALLOWED ON THIS ROAD SURVEY. THE ROAD TO BE **VACATED** IS THAT PORTION OF THE AMERICUS AND ALLEN ROAD COMMENCING AT THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 26-16-11, THEN ANGLING IN A NORTHEAST DIRECTION TO 142 CREEK, A DISTANCE OF SIX (6) MILES.

HIS SURVEY NOTES SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- 1) THE ROAD ALLOWED EXTENDS NORTH ON THE 1/4 SECTION LINE TO THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF THE SW1/4 OF SECTION 29-16-11 AT THE TERMINUS OF THE ROAD ALLOWED
 - 2) THE ROAD ALLOWED EXTENDS SOUTH ON THE 1/4 SECTION LINE TO THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF THE SW1/4 OF SECTION 32-16-11 ON THE TOWNSHIP LINE TO COMMENCE THIS ROAD SURVEY
- 6) COMMISSIONER'S ROAD JOURNAL BOOK "A", PAGE 153
ON JUNE 16, 1937 A PETITION SIGNED BY MARK GRIMSLEY FOR THE VACATION OF THREE ROADS IN TOWNSHIP 16-11 WAS PRESENTED TO THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS. THE ROAD WAS VIEWED BY THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS ON JULY 19, 1937, AND THE FINAL ORDER DATED AUGUST 4, 1937 VACATED THE FOLLOWING ROAD:
- 1) ROAD NUMBER 3: BEGINNING AT THE NORTH QUARTER CORNER OF SECTION 32-16-11 AND RUNNING THENCE NORTH ONE-HALF (1/2) MILE TO THE CENTER OF SECTION 29-16-11; THENCE EAST ONE-HALF (1/2) MILE TO THE EAST QUARTER CORNER OF SAID SECTION 29 AND ENDING THERE.
 - 2) ROAD NUMBER 2: BEGINNING AT THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 32-16-11 AND RUNNING THENCE EAST ON THE SECTION LINE ONE AND ONE-HALF (1-1/2) MILES AND ENDING THERE.
 - 3) SAID ROAD SHOULD BE VACATED. UPON VIEWING THE ROAD PRAYED FOR IN THE PETITION, THE VIEWERS FOUND THAT A PART OF THE ROAD HAD ALREADY BEEN CLOSED TO TRAFFIC BY FENCES BEING BUILT THEREON, AND THERE WAS NO PART OF THE ROAD WHICH WAS TRAVELABLE, THEREFOR, BEING OF NO UTILITY TO THE PUBLIC AS A HIGHWAY.
 - 4) IT WAS FURTHER DETERMINED THAT THERE WAS NO INTEREST IN MAINTAINING A ROAD IN THIS LOCATION AND APPARENTLY NO INCONVENIENCE CAUSED LANDOWNERS IN THE VICINITY OF ITS VACATION.
 - 5) WE, THEREFORE, UNANIMOUSLY DECIDED TO VACATE THE ROAD.
- 7) COMMISSIONER'S ROAD JOURNAL BOOK "B", PAGE 116
PETITION SIGNED BY RALPH MARSH AND OTHERS FOR THE VACATION OF A ROAD IN TOWNSHIP 16-11 WAS PRESENTED TO W. A. STOLFUS, COUNTY CLERK. THE ROAD WAS VIEWED BY THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS ON APRIL 17, 1959 AND THE FINAL ORDER WAS NOT DATED BUT SIGNED BY ALL THREE MEMBERS OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS TO VACATED THE FOLLOWING ROAD:
- 1) BEGINNING AT THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF THE NORTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 32-16-11, FROM THENCE RUNNING SOUTH FOR 113 RODS AND THERE ENDING.
