RANGE 11 EAST**

- 1) ROBERT MILLIKEN, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1870 TO 1875 AND FROM 1882 TO 1883, IN A ROAD SURVEY FOR ROAD NUMBER 207 RECORDED IN ROAD RECORD BOOK "B" ON PAGES 414 TO 416 PETITIONED BY C. B. HOADLEY AND OTHERS FOR A COUNTY ROAD IN TOWNSHIP 16-11 [PACKET 468 IN THE VAULT IN THE COUNTY SURVEYOR'S OFFICE] THAT HE SURVEYED ON MARCH 7, 1883 AND WAS ORDERED ESTABLISHED AS A 50 FOOT WIDE ROAD, WHOLLY ON THE EAST SIDE OF THE LINE FROM THE BEGINNING TO THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF THE SOUTH 1/2 OF THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 32-16-11 AND FROM THERE 1 MILE ON THE WEST SIDE ON ACCOUNT OF STONE AND HEDGE FENCES, THE REST OF THE WAY AS SHOWN BY THE SURVEYORS PLAT AND REPORT, ON APRIL 12, 1883, AND RECORDED ON MAY 2, 1883 BY WILLIAM F. EWING, COUNTY CLERK, SAID THAT **HE FOUND THE STONE** AT THE NORTHWEST CORNER THE SOUTH 1/2 OF THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 32-16-12 ON THIS ROAD SURVEY. SEE THE SURVEY FOR THE DESCRIPTION OF THE CENTERLINE OF THIS ROAD.
