

WEST 1/4 CORNER SECTION 33, TOWNSHIP 16 SOUTH, RANGE 11 EAST

- 1) ON PAGE 295 OF THE GLO ORIGINAL FIELD NOTES IN THE DRAFTING ROOM IN THE COUNTY ENGINEER'S OFFICE IT STATES THAT **THEY SET A LIMESTONE 20" X 16" X 2"** FOR THE 1/4 CORNER BETWEEN SECTIONS 32 & 33-16-11.
- 2) ROBERT MILLIKEN, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1870 TO 1875 AND FROM 1882 TO 1883, IN A **PERMANENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "C" ON PAGE 63 DATED MARCH 1874, SAID THAT **HE FOUND THE STONE** AT THE WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 33-16-11 ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**.
- 3) J. H. HIBBEN, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1875 TO 1882, IN AN **AGREEMENT SURVEY** FOR HORACE D. CURTIS, RICHARD KORKLAUS, RICHARD H. DUNCAN, AND EDWIN MOREHEAD, TO ESTABLISH THE CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 32-16-11 DATED APRIL 15 & 16, 1880, SURVEY F32001 IN THE SURVEY FILE FOR TOWNSHIP 16-11, SAID THAT **HE FOUND THE STONE** AT THE EAST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 32-16-11 ON THIS **AGREEMENT SURVEY**. THIS SURVEY IS FILED IN THE REGISTER OF DEEDS OFFICE.
- 4) C. H. RICE, DEPUTY COUNTY SURVEYOR, IN AN **INFORMAL SURVEY** RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "D" ON PAGE 150 DATED MARCH 30, 1883 AT THE REQUEST OF GRANT, ET. AL. TO ESTABLISH THE CENTER CORNER SECTION 33 AND THE 1/8TH CORNERS ON THE NORTH, EAST & WEST LINES OF THE NORTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 33, ALL IN TOWNSHIP 16, RANGE 11, SAID THAT **HE FOUND THE STONE** AT THE WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 33-16-11 ON THIS **INFORMAL SURVEY**.

 - 1) 80.04 CHAINS EAST TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE EAST 1/4 CORNER SECTION 33-16-11
