- 1) D. T. McAULEY, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1867 TO 1870, IN SURVEY NUMBER 111 RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "A" ON PAGE 202 DATED MAY 4, 1869 FOR A SURVEY OF SECTION 1-16-12, TO ESTABLISH THE CENTER CORNER, AND SUBDIVIDE THE SOUTHEAST 1/4, AND TO ESTABLISH THE 1/4 CORNER ON THE NORTHERN BOUNDARY OF SECTION 1, ALL IN TOWNSHIP 16, RANGE 12, SAID THAT **HE SET A STONE** FOR THE CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 1-16-12 ON LINE BETWEEN THE STONE THAT HE FOUND AT THE SOUTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 1-16-12 AND THE STONE THAT HE SET FOR THE NORTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 1-16-12 AT 160 RODS NORTH OF THE SOUTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 1-16-12 "AS PER LAW" ON THIS SURVEY.

HIS SURVEY NOTES SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- 1) 80 RODS SOUTH TO THE STONE HE SET FOR THE WEST 1/2/4 CORNER OF THE SW1/4 OF SECTION 1-16-12
- 2) 160 RODS SOUTH TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE SOUTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 1-16-12
- 3) 159 RODS, 18 LINKS NORTH TO THE STONE HE SET FOR THE NORTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 1-16-12
- 4) 159 RODS, 23 LINKS EAST TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE EAST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 1-16-12
