

WEST 1/4 CORNER SECTION 01, TOWNSHIP 16 SOUTH, RANGE 12 EAST

- 1) ON PAGE 450 OF THE GLO ORIGINAL FIELD NOTES IN THE DRAFTING ROOM IN THE COUNTY ENGINEER'S OFFICE IT STATES THAT **THEY SET A LIMESTONE 12" X 8" X 6"** FOR THE 1/4 CORNER BETWEEN SECTIONS 1 & 2-16-12.
THE GOVERNMENT SURVEY NOTES SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:
 - 1) 41.06 CHAINS NORTH TO THE 22" X 12" X 3" LIMESTONE THEY SET FOR THE CORNER TO SECTIONS 1 & 2-16-12 ON THE 3RD STANDARD PARALLEL
 - 2) 40.00 CHAINS SOUTH TO THE 24" X 12" X 8" LIMESTONE THEY SET FOR THE CORNER TO SECTIONS 1, 2, 11 & 12-16-12

- 2) D. T. McAULEY, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1867 TO 1870, IN SURVEY NUMBER 112 RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "A" ON PAGE 203 DATED MAY 5, 1869 FOR A SURVEY OF SECTION 2-16-12, TO ESTABLISH THE CENTER CORNER AND THE 1/4 CORNER ON THE NORTHERN BOUNDARY, AND TO REESTABLISH THE 1/4 CORNERS ON THE SOUTHERN AND EASTERN BOUNDARIES OF SECTION 2-16-12, SAID THAT **HE SET A STONE** FOR THE EAST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 2-16-12 ON LINE BETWEEN THE STONES THAT HE FOUND AT THE NORTHEAST CORNER AND THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 2-16-12 AT 160 RODS NORTH OF THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 2-16-12 ON THIS SURVEY.
HIS SURVEY NOTES SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:
 - 1) 160 RODS SOUTH TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 2-16-12
 - 2) 163 RODS, 12 LINKS NORTH TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 2-16-12 ON THE 3RD STANDARD PARALLEL

- 3) J. H. HIBBEN, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1875 TO 1882, IN A ROAD SURVEY RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "C" ON THE RIGHT PAGE 152 DATED FEBRUARY 20, 1878, APPARENTLY **FOUND THE STONE** AT THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 1-16-12 TO BEGIN THIS ROAD SURVEY.
HIS SURVEY NOTES SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:
 - 1) 2,640' NORTH TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 1-16-12 ON THE 3RD STANDARD PARALLEL

- 4) R. H. EDMISTON, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1884 TO 1887, IN SURVEY NUMBER 92, AN ROAD SURVEY RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "E" ON PAGE 94 DATED APRIL 3 & 4, 1885 BY THE ORDER OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS TO LOCATE A COUNTY ROAD IN TOWNSHIP 16-12 FOR THE "POLLOCK BRIDGE" OVER ELM CREEK, SAID THAT **HE FOUND THE STONE** AT THE WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 1-16-12 TO END THIS ROAD SURVEY FOR A 60 FOOT WIDE ROAD.
