

**WEST 1/16 CORNER OF SOUTHEAST QUARTER SECTION 01, TOWNSHIP 16 SOUTH,  
RANGE 12 EAST**

- 1) D. T. McAULEY, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1867 TO 1870, IN SURVEY NUMBER 111 RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "A" ON PAGE 202 DATED MAY 4, 1869 FOR A SURVEY OF SECTION 1-16-12, TO ESTABLISH THE CENTER CORNER, AND SUBDIVIDE THE SOUTHEAST 1/4, AND TO ESTABLISH THE 1/4 CORNER ON THE NORTHERN BOUNDARY OF SECTION 1-16-12, SAID THAT **HE SET A STONE** FOR THE WEST 1/2/4 CORNER OF THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 1-16-12 EQUIDISTANT BETWEEN THE STONE THAT HE FOUND AT THE SOUTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 1-16-12 AND THE STONE THAT HE SET FOR THE CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 1-16-12 ON THIS SURVEY.

**HIS SURVEY NOTES SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:**

- 1) 80 RODS SOUTH TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE SOUTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 1-16-12
- 2) 80 RODS NORTH TO THE STONE HE SET FOR THE CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 1-16-12
- 3) 239 RODS, 18 LINKS NORTH TO THE STONE HE SET FOR THE NORTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 1-16-12 ON THE 3<sup>RD</sup> STANDARD PARALLEL
- 4) 159 RODS, 23 LINKS EAST TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE EAST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 1-16-12 ON THE RANGE LINE
