

CENTER CORNER SECTION 06, TOWNSHIP 16 SOUTH, RANGE 12 EAST

- 1) ROBERT MILLIKEN, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1870 TO 1875 AND FROM 1882 TO 1883, PER C. H. RICE, DEPUTY COUNTY SURVEYOR, IN A **PERMANENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "D" ON PAGE 147 DATED MARCH 6-8, 1883 AT THE ORDER OF GEORGE W. DeCAMP TO PERMANENTLY ESTABLISH THE SOUTHEAST AND NORTHEAST CORNERS OF SECTION 6-16-12, SAID THAT **HE SET A STONE** FOR THE PERMANENT CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 6-16-12 ON LINE BETWEEN THE STONE THAT HE FOUND AT THE SOUTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 6-16-12 WITH THE STONE THAT HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT NORTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 6-16-12 ON THE 3RD STANDARD PARALLEL, AND AT 40.00 CHAINS NORTH OF THE STONE AT THE SOUTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 6-16-12.

- 1) 40.25 CHAINS NORTH TO THE STONE HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT NORTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 6-16-12 ON THE 3RD STANDARD PARALLEL
 - 2) 20.00 CHAINS EAST TO THE STONE HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT NORTH 1/8TH CORNER OF THE SE1/4 OF SECTION 6-16-12
 - 3) 40.00 CHAINS EAST TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE EAST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 6-16-12
 - 4) 40.00 CHAINS SOUTH TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE SOUTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 6
 - 5) 20.00 CHAINS WEST TO THE STONE HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT NORTH 1/8TH CORNER OF THE SW1/4 OF SECTION 6-16-12
 - 6) 32.20 CHAINS WEST TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 6-16-12 ON THE RANGE LINE
- 2) R. H. EDMISTON, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1884 TO 1887, IN SURVEY NUMBER 113, RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "E" ON PAGE 113 DATED AUGUST 17-19, 1885, AND RECORDED IN VOLUME 41 ON PAGE 34 IN THE REGISTER OF DEEDS OFFICE ON JANUARY 27, 1887 AND SURVEY F06001 IN THE SURVEY FILE FOR TOWNSHIP 16-11, SURVEYED PER THE ORDER OF THE **DISTRICT COURT OF LYON COUNTY** TO SURVEY AND SUBDIVIDE SECTION 6-16-12, SAID THAT **HE SET A 3" X 10" X 16" LIMESTONE PROPERLY NOTCHED** FOR THE PERMANENT CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 6-16-12 ON LINE WITH THE STONE THAT HE FOUND AT THE SOUTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 6-16-12 AND THE STONE THAT HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT NORTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 6-16-12 ON THE 3RD STANDARD PARALLEL, AND AT 2,640' NORTH OF THE STONE THAT HE FOUND AT THE SOUTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 6-16-12 ON THIS **DISTRICT COURT ORDERED SURVEY**.
- 3) STEVEN S. BROSEMER, L.S. 752, IN SURVEY F06002 IN THE SURVEY FILE FOR TOWNSHIP 16-12 DATED MAY 9, 2012 FOR PROJECT NUMBER 12098-02, A SURVEY FOR A TRACT IN THE SOUTHWEST QUARTER OF SECTION 6-20-12 FOR BILL MARTIN, SHOWS ON HIS SURVEY DRAWING THAT **HE FOUND A 1" IRON PIN** AT THE CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 6-16-12 FROM A PREVIOUS SURVEY.
