

NORTH 1/16 CORNER NORTHWEST QUARTER OF SECTION 07, TOWNSHIP 16 SOUTH, RANGE 12 EAST

- 1) J. H. HIBBEN, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1875 TO 1882, IN A ROAD SURVEY RECORDED IN ROAD RECORD BOOK "A-1" ON PAGE 114 FOR ROAD NUMBER 29 AND DATED JULY 1879, SAID THAT **HE APPARENTLY FOUND THE NORTH 1/16TH CORNER OF THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 7-16-12 ON THIS ROAD SURVEY.**

- 2) ROBERT MILLIKEN, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1870 TO 1875 AND FROM 1882 TO 1883, PER C. H. RICE, DEPUTY COUNTY SURVEYOR, IN A **PERMANENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "D" ON PAGE 147 DATED MARCH 6-8, 1883 AT THE ORDER OF GEORGE W. DeCAMP TO PERMANENTLY ESTABLISH THE SOUTHEAST AND NORTHEAST CORNERS OF SECTION 6-16-12, SAID THAT **HE SET A WITNESS STONE ONE ROD NORTH OF THE TRUE POSITION DUE TO THE EDGE OF THE WATER OF 142 MILE CREEK** FOR THE PERMANENT SOUTH 1/8TH CORNER OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 6-16-12 ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**, FROM WHICH: A SYCAMORE TREE, 7 FEET DIAMETER AT BUTT, BEARS S. 12° W. AT 48 LINKS DISTANCE
HIS SURVEY NOTES SHOW THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION FROM THE TRUE POSITION FOR THE 1/8TH CORNER:
 - 1) 12.15 CHAINS WEST TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 6-17-12 ON THE RANGE LINE
 - 2) 20.00 CHAINS EAST TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE SOUTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 6-16-12 "SET BY SOME FORMER SURVEYOR WHERE I WOULD HAVE PUT THE 1/4 CORNER ON THE SOUTH LINE OF SECTION 6"
 - 3) 40.00 CHAINS EAST TO THE STONE HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT SOUTH 1/8TH CORNER OF THE SE1/4 OF SECTION 6-16-12
 - 4) 60.00 CHAINS EAST TO THE STONE HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT SOUTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 6-16-12

- 3) R. H. EDMISTON, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1884 TO 1887, IN SURVEY NUMBER 113, RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "E" ON PAGE 113 DATED AUGUST 17-19, 1885, AND RECORDED IN VOLUME 41 ON PAGE 34 IN THE REGISTER OF DEEDS OFFICE ON JANUARY 27, 1887 AND SURVEY F06001 IN THE SURVEY FILE FOR TOWNSHIP 16-11, SURVEYED PER THE ORDER OF THE **DISTRICT COURT OF LYON COUNTY** TO SURVEY AND SUBDIVIDE SECTION 6-16-12, SAID THAT **HE SET A LIMESTONE 3" X 3" ON THE TOP, 4" X 12" AT THE BASE, AND 24" LONG AND PROPERLY NOTCHED MARKED "1/8" AT 16 FEET NORTH OF SECTION LINE DUE TO A CREEK** FOR THE PERMANENT SOUTHWEST CORNER OF THE EAST 1/2 OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 6-16-12 ON THIS **DISTRICT COURT ORDERED SURVEY.**
HIS SURVEY NOTES/DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING DISTANCES FROM THE TRUE POSITION FOR THIS CORNER:
 - 1) 793' WEST TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 6-16-12 ON THE RANGE LINE
 - 2) 1,320' EAST TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE SOUTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 6-16-12
 - 3) 2,640.5' EAST TO THE LOCATION FOR THE PERMANENT SOUTH 1/8TH CORNER OF THE SE1/4 OF SECTION 6-16-12. [**NOTE:** THE 3" X 8" X 16" LIMESTONE WAS OFFSET **12' NORTH** OF THE TRUE POSITION – WARREN CHIP WOODS, L.S. 603, COUNTY SURVEYOR]
 - 4) 3,961' EAST TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 6-16-12
 - 5) 6,613' EAST TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE SOUTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 5-16-12
 - 6) 9,265' EAST TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 5-16-12
