RANGE 12 EAST**

- 1) D. T. McAULEY, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1867 TO 1870, IN SURVEY NUMBER 111 RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "A" ON PAGE 202 DATED MAY 4, 1869 FOR A SURVEY OF SECTION 1-16-12, TO ESTABLISH THE CENTER CORNER, AND SUBDIVIDE THE SOUTHEAST 1/4, AND TO ESTABLISH THE 1/4 CORNER ON THE NORTHERN BOUNDARY OF SECTION 1-16-12, SAID THAT **HE SET A STONE** FOR THE SOUTH 1/2/4 CORNER OF THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 1-16-12 EQUIDISTANT BETWEEN THE STONE THAT HE FOUND AT THE SOUTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 1-16-12 AND THE STONE THAT HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 1-16-12 ON THIS SURVEY.
