EDMISTON, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1884 TO 1887, IN SURVEY NUMBER 25, A **PERMANENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "E" ON PAGE 25 DATED APRIL 3 & 4, 1884 TO SUBDIVIDE THE NORTHWEST AND SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 16-16-12 FOR J. E. WALLINGFORD, SAID THAT **HE FOUND THE STONE** AT THE CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 16-16-12 ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**.
HIS SURVEY NOTES/DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:
 - 1) 1,320' WEST TO THE STONE HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT NORTH 1/8TH CORNER OF THE SW1/4 OF SECTION 16-16-12
 - 2) 2,640' WEST TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 16-16-12
