

**NORTH 1/16 CORNER SOUTHWEST QUARTER OF SECTION 16, TOWNSHIP 16 SOUTH,
RANGE 12 EAST**

- 1) R. H. EDMISTON, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1884 TO 1887, IN SURVEY NUMBER 25, A **PERMANENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "E" ON PAGE 25 DATED APRIL 3 & 4, 1884 TO SUBDIVIDE THE NORTHWEST AND SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 16-16-12 FOR J. E. WALLINGFORD, SAID THAT **HE SET A STONE** FOR THE PERMANENT NORTH 1/8TH CORNER OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 16-16-12 ON LINE AND HALFWAY BETWEEN THE STONES THAT HE FOUND AT THE WEST 1/4 CORNER AND THE CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 16-16-12 ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**.

HIS SURVEY NOTES/DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- 1) 1,320' WEST TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 16-16-12
- 2) 1,320' EAST TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 16-16-12
- 3) 1,326.5' NORTH TO THE STONE HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT CENTER CORNER OF THE NW1/4 OF SECTION 16-16-12
- 4) 2,653' NORTH TO A STONE HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT NORTH 1/8TH CORNER OF THE NW1/4 OF SECTION 16-16-12
- 5) 1,326.5' SOUTH TO THE STONE HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT CENTER CORNER OF THE SW1/4 OF SECTION 16-16-12
