

**CENTER CORNER SECTION 22, TOWNSHIP 16 SOUTH, RANGE 12 EAST**

- 1) G. M. WALKER, BRECKENRIDGE COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1857 TO 1860, IN SURVEY NUMBER 31 OF THE SECOND TERM RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "A" ON PAGES 34 & 35 DATED JUNE 9, 1859 TO ESTABLISH THE CENTER POST AND TO DIVIDE THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 AND THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 22-16-12, SAID THAT **HE SET THE STONE CENTER POST OF SECTION 22-16-12 EQUIDISTANT FROM THE OPPOSITE STONE 1/4 POSTS ON THIS SURVEY.**

  - 3) 20.04 CHAINS EAST TO THE STAKE HE SET FOR THE N1/4/4 POST OF THE SE1/4 OF SECTION 22-16-12
  - 4) 40.08 CHAINS EAST TO THE FOUND STONE EAST 1/4 POST OF SECTION 22-16-12
  - 5) 20.03 CHAINS SOUTH TO THE STAKE HE SET FOR THE W1/4/4 POST OF THE SE1/4 OF SECTION 22-16-12
  - 6) 40.06 CHAINS SOUTH TO THE FOUND STONE SOUTH 1/4 POST OF SEC. 22-16-12
  - 7) 40.06 CHAINS NORTH TO THE FOUND STONE NORTH 1/4 POST OF SEC. 22-16-12
