

**WEST 1/16 CORNER SOUTHEAST QUARTER OF SECTION 22, TOWNSHIP 16 SOUTH,
RANGE 12 EAST**

- 1) G. M. WALKER, BRECKENRIDGE COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1857 TO 1860, IN SURVEY NUMBER 31 OF THE SECOND TERM RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "A" ON PAGES 34 & 35 DATED JUNE 9, 1859 TO ESTABLISH THE CENTER POST AND TO DIVIDE THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 AND THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 22-16-12, SAID THAT **HE SET A STAKE** FOR THE WEST 1/4/4 POST OF THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 22-16-12 ON LINE AND HALFWAY BETWEEN THE FOUND STONE SOUTH 1/4 POST OF SECTION 22-16-12 AND THE STAKE THAT HE SET FOR THE CENTER POST OF SECTION 22-16-12 ON THIS SURVEY.

HIS SURVEY NOTES SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- 1) 20.03 CHAINS SOUTH TO THE FOUND STONE SOUTH 1/4 POST OF SEC. 22-16-12
- 2) 20.03 CHAINS NORTH TO THE STAKE HE SET FOR THE CENTER POST OF SECTION 22-16-12
- 3) 60.09 CHAINS NORTH TO THE FOUND STONE NORTH 1/4 POST OF SEC. 22-16-12
