

**WEST 1/16 CORNER OF SOUTHWEST QUARTER SECTION 28, TOWNSHIP 16 SOUTH,
RANGE 12 EAST**

- 1) ROBERT MILLIKEN, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1870 TO 1875 AND FROM 1882 TO 1883, IN A ROAD SURVEY RECORDED IN ROAD RECORD BOOK "A" ON PAGES 158 TO 160 [PACKET 311 IN THE VAULT IN THE COUNTY SURVEYOR'S OFFICE] PETITIONED BY B. G. H. WILBUR AND OTHERS FOR A ROAD IN TOWNSHIPS 16-12, 17-11 AND 17-12, SURVEYED AUGUST 27, 1870, ESTABLISHED BY THE ORDER OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS ON SEPTEMBER 5TH, 1870 AS A 50 FOOT WIDE ROAD, AND FILED AND RECORDED ON THE 5TH DAY OF SEPTEMBER 1870 BY DAVID S. GILMORE, COUNTY CLERK, SAID THAT THERE WAS A TURN TO THE SOUTHWEST DUE TO HILL CREEK AT **3,960 FEET SOUTH** OF THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 21-16-12 ON THIS ROAD SURVEY.

HIS SURVEY NOTES SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- 1) THIS ROAD EXTENDS NORTH ON THE SECTION LINE BETWEEN SECTIONS 28 & 29-16-12 FOR 3,960' TO THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 21-16-12
