

CENTER CORNER SECTION 33, TOWNSHIP 16 SOUTH, RANGE 12 EAST

- 1) ROBERT MILLIKEN, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1870 TO 1875 AND FROM 1882 TO 1883, IN SURVEY NUMBER 12 OF THE 8TH TERM, A **PERMANENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "C" ON PAGE 67 DATED MARCH 24, 1874 TO ESTABLISH THE CENTER CORNER AND THE CORNERS TO THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 OF THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 33-16-12, SAID THAT **HE SET A 15" X 14" X 2" STONE** FOR THE PERMANENT CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 33-16-12 AT THE INTERSECTION OF THE LINES FROM THE OPPOSITE 1/4 CORNERS ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**.

HIS SURVEY NOTES SHOW THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- 1) 1,333' WEST TO THE 20" X 10" X 8" STONE HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT SOUTH 1/2/4 CORNER OF THE NW1/4 OF SECTION 33-16-12
- 2) 2,666' WEST TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 33-16-12
