

**CENTER CORNER NORTHWEST QUARTER OF SECTION 33, TOWNSHIP 16 SOUTH,
RANGE 12 EAST**

- 1) ROBERT MILLIKEN, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1870 TO 1875 AND FROM 1882 TO 1883, IN SURVEY NUMBER 12 OF THE 8TH TERM, A **PERMANENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "C" ON PAGE 67 DATED MARCH 24, 1874 TO ESTABLISH THE CENTER CORNER AND THE CORNERS TO THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 OF THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 33-16-12, SAID THAT **HE SET A STONE** FOR THE PERMANENT 1/4/4 CORNER IN THE CENTER OF THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 33-16-12 ON LINE AND HALFWAY BETWEEN THE 20" X 10" X 8" STONE THAT HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT SOUTH 1/2/4 CORNER OF THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 33-16-12 AND THE POST THAT HE SET FOR THE TEMPORARY NORTH 1/2/4 CORNER OF THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 33-16-12 ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**.

HIS SURVEY NOTES SHOW THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- 1) 1,330-1/2' NORTH TO THE POST HE SET FOR THE TEMPORARY NORTH 1/2/4 CORNER OF THE NW1/4 OF SECTION 33-16-12
- 2) 1,330-1/2' SOUTH TO THE 20" X 10" X 8" STONE HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT SOUTH 1/2/4 CORNER OF THE NW1/4 OF SECTION 33-16-12

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
