

**NORTH 1/16 CORNER NORTHWEST QUARTER OF SECTION 34, TOWNSHIP 16 SOUTH,
RANGE 12 EAST**

1) FRANK P. MACLEMAN, DEPUTY COUNTY SURVEYOR, IN A **PERMANENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "C" ON PAGE 211 DATED MAY 16-22, 1878, ORDERED BY LYMAN BETTS AND OTHERS TO SUBDIVIDE SECTION 34-16-12, SAID THAT **HE SET A STONE** FOR THE PERMANENT NORTHWEST CORNER OF THE NORTHEAST 1/4 OF THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 34-16-12 ON LINE AND AT THE MIDDLE POINT BETWEEN THE STONE THAT HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT NORTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 34-16-12 AND THE STONE THAT HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT NORTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 34-16-12 ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**.

- 1) 79 RODS, 19.1 LINKS WEST TO THE STONE HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT NORTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 34-16-12
- 2) 79 RODS, 19.1 LINKS EAST TO THE STONE HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT NORTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 34-16-12
- 3) 239 RODS, 7.3 LINKS EAST TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 34-16-12
- 4) 160 RODS, 2.3 LINKS SOUTH TO THE STONE HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT SOUTHWEST CORNER OF THE SE1/4 OF THE NW1/4 OF SECTION 34-16-12
