

**WEST 1/16 CORNER OF SOUTHWEST QUARTER SECTION 36, TOWNSHIP 16 SOUTH,  
RANGE 12 EAST**

- 1) ROBERT MILLIKEN, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1870 TO 1875 AND FROM 1882 TO 1883, IN SURVEY NUMBER 25, A **PERMANENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "B" ON PAGE 25 DATED APRIL 6, 1870 TO ESTABLISH THE CENTER OF SECTION 36-16-12 AND THE CENTER OF THE NORTHWEST 1/4 AND THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 AND TO SUBDIVIDE THE 1/4'S INTO 40 ACRE LOTS, SAID THAT **HE SET A STONE** FOR THE PERMANENT WEST 1/2/4 CORNER OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 36-16-12 ON LINE AND HALFWAY BETWEEN THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 36-16-12 AND THE STONE THAT HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 36-16-12 ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**.

**HIS SURVEY NOTES SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:**

- 1) 1,320' SOUTH TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 36-16-12 ON THE TOWNSHIP LINE
- 2) 1,320' NORTH TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 36-16-12
- 3) 2,633-1/4' NORTH TO THE STONE HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT WEST 1/2/4 CORNER OF THE NW1/4 OF SECTION 36-16-12
- 4) 3,946-1/2' NORTH TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 36-16-12
