

**NORTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 08, TOWNSHIP 16 SOUTH, RANGE 13 EAST**

- 1) ON PAGE 614 OF THE GLO ORIGINAL FIELD NOTES IN THE DRAFTING ROOM IN THE COUNTY ENGINEER'S OFFICE IT STATES THAT **THEY SET A LIMESTONE 18" X 11" X 6"** FOR THE CORNER TO SECTIONS 5, 6, 7 & 8-16-13.

THE GOVERNMENT SURVEY NOTES SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- 1) 40.00 CHAINS NORTH TO THE 15" X 8" X 6" LIMESTONE THEY SET FOR THE 1/4 CORNER BETWEEN SECTIONS 5 & 6-16-13
- 2) 79.60 CHAINS NORTH TO THE 20" X 18" X 4" LIMESTONE THEY SET FOR THE CLOSING CORNER TO SECTIONS 5 & 6 ON THE 3<sup>RD</sup> STANDARD PARALLEL
- 3) 40.00 CHAINS EAST TO THE 16" x 12" X 5" LIMESTONE THEY SET FOR THE 1/4 CORNER BETWEEN SECTIONS 5 & 8-16-13
- 4) 80.00 CHAINS EAST TO THE 18' X 15" X 3" LIMESTONE THEY SET FOR THE CORNER TO SECTIONS 4, 5, 8 & 9-16-13
- 5) 33.00 CHAINS WEST TO THE 18" X 16" X 4" LIMESTONE MARKED "CC" THEY SET ON THE WEST BOUNDARY OF THE SAC & FOX INDIAN LANDS
- 6) 40.04 CHAINS WEST TO THE 19" X 18" X 6" LIMESTONE THEY SET FOR THE 1/4 CORNER BETWEEN SECTION 6 & 7-16-13
- 7) 80.04 CHAINS WEST TO THE 23" X 12" X 3" LIMESTONE THEY SET FOR THE CORNER TO SECTIONS 1, 6, 7 & 12 ON THE TOWNSHIP BOUNDARY

- 2) ROBERT MILLIKEN, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1870 TO 1875 AND FROM 1882 TO 1883, IN A ROAD SURVEY RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "F" ON PAGE 11 DATED MAY 31, 1882 FOR A ROAD IN TOWNSHIP 16-13, SAID THAT **HE FOUND THE STONE STANDING** AT THE CORNER TO SECTIONS 5, 6, 7 & 8-19-13 ON THIS ROAD SURVEY. HE NOTED THAT THE WIDTH WAS ORDERED TO BE 60 FEET.

HIS SURVEY NOTES SHOW THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- 1) THIS ROAD EXTENDS WEST ON THE SECTION LINES FOR 2,192 FEET TO THE STONE HE FOUND ON THE WEST BOUNDARY OF THE SAC & FOX TRUST LANDS AT THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF LOT 4 ON THE SOUTH SIDE OF SECTION 6-16-13 TO COMMENCE THIS ROAD SURVEY

- 3) ROBERT MILLIKEN, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1870 TO 1875 AND FROM 1882 TO 1883, IN A ROAD SURVEY FOR ROAD 179 RECORDED IN ROAD RECORD BOOK "B" ON PAGES 302 TO 304 PETITION BY JOHN M. WILBUR AND OTHERS FOR A COUNTY ROAD IN TOWNSHIP 16-13 [PACKET 427 IN THE VAULT IN THE COUNTY SURVEYOR'S OFFICE] THAT HE SURVEYED ON MAY 31, 1882, WAS ESTABLISHED AS A 60 FOOT ROAD ON JULY 11, 1882 AS NOTED BY HUGH F. HOLMES, CHAIRMAN OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, AND RECORDED ON JULY 22, 1882 BY WILLIAM F. EWING, COUNTY CLERK, SAID THAT **HE FOUND THE STONE** AT THE CORNER TO SECTIONS 5, 6, 7 & 8-16-13 THIS ROAD SURVEY.

HIS NOTES SHOW THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- 3) THIS ROAD EXTENDS WEST ON THE SECTION LINES FOR 2,192 FEET TO THE STONE HE FOUND ON THE WEST BOUNDARY OF THE SAC & FOX TRUST LANDS AT THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF LOT 4 ON THE SOUTH SIDE OF SECTION 6-16-13 TO COMMENCE THIS ROAD SURVEY
- 4) THIS ROAD EXTENDS EAST ON THE SECTION LINES FOR 2,652 FEET TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE NORTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 8-16-13; THEN

CONTINUES EAST ON THE SECTION LINES FOR 2,650 FEET TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 9-16-13; THEN CONTINUES EAST ON THE SECTION LINES FOR 2,651 FEET TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE NORTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 9-16-13; THEN CONTINUES EAST ON THE SECTION LINES FOR 2,640 FEET TO THE STONE HE SET FOR THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 9-16-13 AT THE TERMINUS OF THIS ROAD SURVEY

WARREN CHIP WOODS, L.S. 603, COUNTY SURVEYOR** REA BOOK 30 ON PAGE 25.5 SAYS THAT **THEY DROVE AN IRON PIN** FOR THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 6-16-13 **“AS HE BELIEVED”**. THEY DID NOT LIST ANY REFERENCES.

BELL, P.E. 1291, IN THE FOLDER LABELED “TURNPIKE RIGHT-OF-WAY” IN THE DRAWER LABELED KANSAS TURNPIKE” IN THE RECORDS ROOM IN THE COUNTY ENGINEER’S OFFICE FOR KANSAS TURNPIKE TRACT NUMBER 23-5-A FOR A 3.08 ACRE TRACT OWNED BY LAURELL FAGER IN THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 8-16-13 FOR CONDEMNATION CASE NUMBER 23600 FILED 6-21-55, SHOWS ON HIS SURVEY DRAWING THAT **HE FOUND** THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 8-16-13 AND THE POINT OF BEGINNING OF THE DESCRIBED TRACT. THERE IS NO DESCRIPTION OF THE MONUMENT AND THERE ARE NO TIES ON THE SURVEY OR IN THE SURVEY TIE FILES.
