

**NORTH 1/4 CORNER SECTION 02, TOWNSHIP 17 SOUTH, RANGE 10 EAST**

- 1) ON PAGE 56 OF THE GLO ORIGINAL FIELD NOTES IN THE DRAFTING ROOM IN THE COUNTY ENGINEER'S OFFICE IT STATES THAT **THEY SET A LIMESTONE 18" X 14" X 3"** FOR THE NORTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 2-17-10 ON THE TOWNSHIP LINE ON JANUARY 9, 1861.

THE GOVERNMENT SURVEY NOTES SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- 1) 40.00 CHAINS WEST ON THE TOWNSHIP LINE TO THE 18" X 10" X 4" LIMESTONE THEY SET FOR THE CORNER TO SECTIONS 2 & 3-17-10
- 2) 40.00 CHAINS EAST ON THE TOWNSHIP LINE TO THE 20" X 12" X 4" LIMESTONE THEY SET FOR THE CORNER TO SECTIONS 1 & 2-17-10

- 2) R. H. EDMISTON, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1884 TO 1887, IN SURVEY NUMBER 171, A **CONSENT SURVEY** OF ALL INTERESTED PARTIES RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "E" ON PAGE 171 DATED JUNE 9, 1887 TO LOCATED THE CENTER AND EAST 1/4 CORNERS OF SECTION 1-17-10, SAID THAT **HE FOUND THE STONE** AT THE NORTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 2-17-10 ON THE TOWNSHIP LINE ON THIS **CONSENT SURVEY**.

HIS SURVEY NOTES/DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- 1) 2,645-2/3' EAST ON THE TOWNSHIP LINE TO THE THEORETICAL LOCATION FOR THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 1-17-10
- 2) 5,291-1/3' EAST ON THE TOWNSHIP LINE TO THE TEMPORARY STAKE HE DROVE FOR THE NORTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 1-17-10
- 3) 7,937' EAST ON THE TOWNSHIP LINE TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE TOWNSHIP CORNER AT THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 1-17-10

- 3) **REA PIN—MUST VERIFY AND CHECK FOR THE STONE OF RECORD BEFORE USING AS THIS IRON PIN WAS PROBABLY "HEELED-IN" FOR UTILITY USE ONLY – WARREN CHIP WOODS, L.S. 603, COUNTY SURVEYOR** REA BOOK 30 ON PAGE 16 SAYS THAT **THEY SET AN IRON PIN** FOR THE SOUTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 35-16-10 ON THE TOWNSHIP LINE, IN LINE WITH HEDGES NORTH AND SOUTH **NEAR** THE SOUTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 35-16-10 AT 2,645 FEET EAST OF THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 2-17-10.

- 1) 23' SOUTH TO A WITNESS PIN

- 4) THE KRETSINGER REFERENCE TIE BOOK FOR TOWNSHIP 17 -10 SHOWS A **REA PIN** AT THE "NW CORNER NE1/4 SECTION 2-17-10" ON THE TOWNSHIP LINE. **VERIFY AND CHECK FOR THE STONE OF RECORD BEFORE USING AS THIS IRON PIN WAS PROBABLY "HEELED-IN" FOR UTILITY USE ONLY – WARREN CHIP WOODS, L.S. 603, COUNTY SURVEYOR**
