

CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 04, TOWNSHIP 17 SOUTH, RANGE 10 EAST

- 1) ROBERT MILLIKEN, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1870 TO 1875 AND FROM 1882 TO 1883, IN SURVEY NUMBER 23 OF THE 8TH TERM, A **PERMANENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "C" ON PAGE 78 DATED MAY 12, 1874 TO ESTABLISH THE CENTER CORNER AND THE CORNERS OF THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 AND THE NORTHEAST 1/4 OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 4-17-10, SAID THAT **HE SET AN 18" X 10" X 5" LIMESTONE** FOR THE PERMANENT CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 4-17-10 AT THE INTERSECTION OF THE LINES FROM THE OPPOSITE 1/4 CORNERS ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**.
HIS SURVEY NOTES SHOW THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:
- 1) 1,324' WEST TO THE 24" X 12" X 2" LIMESTONE HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT NORTH 1/2/4 CORNER OF THE SW1/4 OF SECTION 4-17-10
 - 2) 2,648' WEST TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 4-17-10
 - 3) 1,321.5' EAST TO THE 24" X 12" X 4" LIMESTONE HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT NORTH 1/2/4 CORNER OF THE SE1/4 OF SECTION 4-17-10
 - 4) 2,643' EAST TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE EAST 1/4 CORNER OF SEC. 4-17-10
 - 5) 1,325' SOUTH TO THE 16" X 10" X 3" LIMESTONE HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT WEST 1/2/4 CORNER OF THE SE1/4 OF SECTION 4-17-10
 - 6) 2,650' SOUTH TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE SOUTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 4-17-10

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
