

**CENTER CORNER OF SOUTHWEST 1/4 SECTION 04, TOWNSHIP 17 SOUTH, RANGE 10 EAST**

- 1) ROBERT MILLIKEN, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1870 TO 1875 AND FROM 1882 TO 1883, IN SURVEY NUMBER 23 OF THE 8<sup>TH</sup> TERM, A **PERMANENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "C" ON PAGE 78 DATED MAY 12, 1874 TO ESTABLISH THE CENTER CORNER AND THE CORNERS OF THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 AND THE NORTHEAST 1/4 OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 4-17-10, SAID THAT **HE SET A STONE** FOR THE PERMANENT 1/4/4 CORNER IN THE CENTER OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 4-17-10 ON LINE AND HALFWAY BETWEEN THE POST THAT HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT WEST 1/2/4 CORNER THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 4-17-10 AND THE 16" X 10" X 3" LIMESTONE THAT HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT EAST 1/2/4 CORNER OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 4-17-10 ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**.

**HIS SURVEY NOTES SHOW THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:**

- 1) 1,321' WEST TO THE POST HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT WEST 1/2/4 CORNER OF THE SW1/4 OF SECTION 4-17-10
- 2) 1,321' EAST TO THE 16" X 10" X 3" LIMESTONE HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT EAST 1/2/4 CORNER OF THE SW1/4 OF SECTION 4-17-10
