

**NORTH 1/16 CORNER OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 SECTION 06, TOWNSHIP 17 SOUTH,
RANGE 10 EAST**

- 1) J. H. HIBBEN, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1875 TO 1882, IN A ROAD SURVEY RECORDED IN ROAD RECORD BOOK "A-1" ON PAGES 154 & 155 FOR A PETITION BY W. T KITCHEN [PACKET 134 IN THE VAULT IN THE COUNTY SURVEYOR'S OFFICE] DATED SEPTEMBER 1879, SAID THAT **HE FOUND THE STONE** AT THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF THE NORTHWEST 1/4 SECTION 6-17-10 ON THIS ROAD SURVEY FOR A 60 FOOT ROAD.

- 2) R. H. EDMISTON, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1884 TO 1887, IN SURVEY NUMBER 17 RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "E" ON PAGE 17 DATED MARCH 11, 1884 FOR A ROAD SURVEY IN TOWNSHIPS 16 & 17, RANGE 10 FOR CALVIN HOOD, PRINCIPAL PETITIONER, SAID THAT **HE FOUND THE STONE** AT THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 6-17-10 ON THIS ROAD SURVEY.
HIS SURVEY NOTES/DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:
 - 1) 1,320' WEST TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 6-17-10 ON THE RANGE LINE AND THE LYON AND MORRIS COUNTY LINE AT THE TERMINUS OF THIS ROAD SURVEY
 - 2) 1,320' NORTH TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF THE NW1/4 OF THE NW1/4 OF SECTION 6-17-10

- 3) ROBERT MILLIKEN, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1870 TO 1875 AND FROM 1882 TO 1883, IN A ROAD SURVEY RECORDED IN ROAD RECORD BOOK "B" ON PAGES 558 AND 559 FOR ROAD NUMBER 243 BY A PETITION BY CALVIN HOOD [PACKET 505 IN THE VAULT IN THE COUNTY SURVEYOR'S OFFICE] DATED APRIL 1884, SAID THAT **HE FOUND THE STONE** AT THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 6-17-10 ON THIS ROAD SURVEY.
