

NORTHWEST CORNER SECTION 06, TOWNSHIP 17 SOUTH, RANGE 10 EAST

- 1) ON PAGE 37 OF THE GLO ORIGINAL FIELD NOTES IN THE DRAFTING ROOM IN THE COUNTY ENGINEER'S OFFICE IT STATES THAT **THEY SET A LIMESTONE 24" X 12" X 6"** FOR THE CORNER TO TOWNSHIPS 16 & 17 SOUTH, RANGES 9 & 10 EAST ON THE WEST TOWNSHIP BOUNDARY AND THE COUNTY LINE AT THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 6-17-10.

THE GOVERNMENT SURVEY NOTES SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- 1) 38.34 CHAINS EAST ON THE TOWNSHIP LINE TO THE 20" X 10" X 3" LIMESTONE THEY SET FOR THE NORTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 6-17-10
- 2) 78.34 CHAINS EAST ON THE TOWNSHIP LINE TO THE 28" X 16" X 3" LIMESTONE THEY SET FOR THE CORNER TO SECTIONS 5 & 6-17-10
- 3) 40.00 CHAINS SOUTH ON THE WEST TOWNSHIP BOUNDARY AND THE COUNTY LINE TO THE 18" X 12" X 5" LIMESTONE THEY SET FOR THE WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 6-17-10
- 4) 80.00 CHAINS SOUTH ON THE WEST TOWNSHIP BOUNDARY AND THE COUNTY LINE TO THE 24" X 15" X 3" LIMESTONE THEY SET FOR THE CORNER TO SECTIONS 6 & 7-17-10

- 2) J. H. HIBBEN, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1875 TO 1882, IN A ROAD SURVEY FOR ROAD NUMBER 62 RECORDED IN ROAD RECORD BOOK "A-1" ON PAGES 250 TO 252 PETITIONED BY JOHN R. MAYS AND OTHERS FOR A COUNTY ROAD IN TOWNSHIPS 17-10 AND 17-11 ON THE TOWNSHIP LINES [PACKET 329 IN THE VAULT IN THE COUNTY SURVEYOR'S OFFICE] THAT HE SURVEYED ON MARCH 22, 1880, WAS ESTABLISHED AS A 50 FOOT WIDE ROAD ON APRIL 12, 1880, AND WAS RECORDED ON APRIL 20, 1880 BY WILLIAM F. EWING, COUNTY CLERK, SAID THAT **HE FOUND THE STONE** AT THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 6-17-10 ON THE RANGE LINE AND THE LYON AND MORRIS COUNTY LINE AT THE TERMINUS OF THIS ROAD SURVEY.

HIS SURVEY NOTES SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- 1) THIS ROAD EXTENDS EAST ON THE TOWNSHIP LINE FOR 12 MILES TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 1-17-11 ON THE RANGE LINE TO COMMENCE THIS ROAD SURVEY
- 3) J. H. HIBBEN, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1875 TO 1882, IN A ROAD SURVEY RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "C" ON THE RIGHT SIDE PAGE 178 DATED MARCH 23, 1880, FOR A COUNTY ROAD IN TOWNSHIPS 16-10 AND 16-11, APPARENTLY **FOUND THE STONE** AT THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 6-17-10 ON THE RANGE LINE AND THE LYON AND MORRIS COUNTY LINE AT THE TERMINUS OF THIS ROAD SURVEY.

HIS SURVEY NOTES SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- 1) THIS ROAD EXTENDS EAST ON THE TOWNSHIP LINE FOR 12 MILES TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 1-17-11 ON THE RANGE LINE TO COMMENCE THIS ROAD SURVEY
- 4) ROBERT MILLIKEN, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1870 TO 1875 AND FROM 1882 TO 1883, IN A ROAD SURVEY FOR ROAD NUMBER 215 RECORDED IN ROAD RECORD BOOK "B" ON PAGES 446 TO 448 PETITION BY E. BARCLAY AND OTHERS FOR A ROAD ON THE LYON AND MORRIS COUNTY LINE BETWEEN TOWNSHIPS 16-10 AND 17-10 [PACKET 458 IN THE VAULT IN THE COUNTY SURVEYOR'S OFFICE] THAT HE SURVEYED ON MAY 28 AND JUNE 1, 1883, AND WAS ESTABLISHED AS A 50 FOOT WIDE ROAD FROM THE BEGINNING, WHICH IS THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 18-17-10, TO THE FOOT OF THE HILL WHERE AN ANGLE IS MADE NEAR THE WEST LINE OF THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 30-16-10, AND IT IS 40 FEET WIDE FROM THERE TO THE TERMINUS OF THIS ROAD SURVEY, AS NOTED BY J. E. JONES, CHAIRMAN OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, SAID THAT **HE**

FOUND THE STONE AT THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 31-16-10 AT THE TOWNSHIP CORNER ON THE RANGE LINE AND THE LYON AND MORRIS COUNTY LINE ON THIS ROAD SURVEY ON THE COUNTY LINE.

HIS SURVEY NOTES SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- 1) THIS ROAD EXTENDS NORTH ON THE COUNTY LINE FOR 154-1/2 RODS TO AN ANGLE STONE MARKED "R+" HE SET TO BEGIN NUMEROUS ANGLES AND INTERSECTS THE COUNTY LINE AT THE WEST 1/16TH CORNER OF THE SW1/4 OF SECTION 19-16-10; THEN CONTINUES NORTH ON THE COUNTY LINE FOR 3/4 OF A MILE TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 19-16-10 AT THE TERMINUS OF THIS ROAD SURVEY
 - 2) THIS ROAD EXTENDS SOUTH ON THE COUNTY LINE FOR 2 MILES TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 18-17-10 TO COMMENCE THIS ROAD SURVEY
- 5) R. H. EDMISTON, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1884 TO 1887, BY MATTHEW BROWN, DEPUTY COUNTY SURVEYOR, IN SURVEY NUMBER 93, A **PERMANENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "F" ON PAGE 99 DATED JUNE 17-30, 1886 AND RECORDED IN MISCELLANEOUS VOLUME 36 ON PAGES 495 & 496 IN THE REGISTER OF DEEDS OFFICE ON SEPTEMBER 2, 1886, TO ESTABLISH THE MISSING CORNERS AND SUBDIVIDE SECTION 7-17-10, SAID THAT **HE FOUND THE STONE** AT THE TOWNSHIP CORNER AT THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 6-17-10 ON THE RANGE LINE AND THE LYON AND MORRIS COUNTY LINE ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**.

HIS SURVEY NOTES/DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- 1) 79.52 CHAINS SOUTH ON THE RANGE LINE AND THE COUNTY LINE TO THE 15" X 12" X 2" STONE WITH 1 NOTCH ON THE EAST EDGE AND 5 NOTCHES ON THE WEST EDGE HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT NORTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 7-17-10
 - 2) 119.29 CHAINS SOUTH ON THE RANGE LINE AND THE COUNTY LINE TO THE 18" X 12" X 4" STONE MARKED "1/4" ON THE WEST FACE HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 7-17-10
 - 3) 134.73 CHAINS SOUTH ON THE RANGE LINE AND THE COUNTY LINE TO THE PROPERTY STONE MARKED "60" HE SET ON THIS SURVEY
 - 4) 159.05 CHAINS SOUTH ON THE RANGE LINE AND THE COUNTY LINE TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 7-17-10
- 6) COMMISSIONER'S ROAD JOURNAL BOOK "A", PAGE 78
ON MAY 7, 1923 A PETITION SIGNED BY FRANK ALLISON AND OTHERS FOR THE **VACATION** OF A ROAD IN TOWNSHIP 15-11 WAS PRESENTED TO THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS. THE ROAD WAS VIEWED ON JUNE 7, 1923, AND THE FINAL ORDER WAS ISSUED ON JULY 2, 1923 TO **VACATE** THE ROAD AS FOLLOWS:
- 1) BEGINNING AT THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 31-16-10; FROM THENCE NORTH ABOUT 80 RODS; THENCE NORTHEASTERLY AND NORTHERLY TO THE SECTION LINE ON THE NORTH SIDE OF SECTION 31-16-10 AND THERE ENDING
- 7) THE KRETSINGER REFERENCE TIE BOOK FOR TOWNSHIP 16-10 SHOWS A **STONE** AT THE "SW CORNER SECTION 31-16-10" AT THE TOWNSHIP CORNER ON THE LYON AND MORRIS COUNTY LINE.
- 1) 34.5' SW TO A TELEPHONE POLE
 - 2) 39.4' NW TO A 24" MAPLE TREE
- 8) KRETSINGER REFERENCE TIE BOOK NUMBER 13 ON PAGE 49 AT THE TOP OF THE PAGE SHOWS A **STONE** AT THE "SW CORNER SECTION 31-16-10" AT THE TOWNSHIP CORNER ON THE LYON AND MORRIS COUNTY LINE.
- 1) 34.2' NW TO THE NEAR FACE OF A 24" MAPLE TREE AT 12" ABOVE THE GROUND
 - 2) 34.2' SW TO THE NEAR FACE OF A TELEPHONE POLE
