

**WEST 1/4 CORNER SECTION 06, TOWNSHIP 17 SOUTH, RANGE 10 EAST**

- 1) ON PAGE 37 OF THE GLO ORIGINAL FIELD NOTES IN THE DRAFTING ROOM IN THE COUNTY ENGINEER'S OFFICE IT STATES THAT THEY SET A **LIMESTONE 18" X 12" X 5"** AT THE WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 6-17-10 ON THE WEST TOWNSHIP BOUNDARY AND THE COUNTY LINE.

THE GOVERNMENT SURVEY NOTES SHOW THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- 1) 40.00 CHAINS NORTH ON THE WEST TOWNSHIP BOUNDARY AND THE COUNTY LINE TO THE 24" X 12" X 6" LIMESTONE THEY SET FOR THE CORNER TO TOWNSHIPS 16 & 17 SOUTH, RANGES 9 & 10 EAST
- 2) 40.00 CHAINS SOUTH ON THE WEST TOWNSHIP BOUNDARY AND THE COUNTY LINE TO THE 24" X 15" X 3" LIMESTONE THEY SET FOR THE CORNER TO SECTIONS 6 & 7-17-10

- 2) J. H. HIBBEN, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1875 TO 1882, IN A ROAD SURVEY FOR ROAD NUMBER 38 RECORDED IN ROAD RECORD BOOK "A-1" ON PAGES 154 TO 156 PETITION BY W. T KITCHEN AND OTHERS FOR THREE ROADS IN TOWNSHIPS 16-10 AND 17-10 [PACKET 134 IN THE VAULT IN THE COUNTY SURVEYOR'S OFFICE] THAT HE SURVEYED ON SEPTEMBER 2, 1879, WERE ESTABLISHED AT 60 FEET WIDE ON OCTOBER 6, 1879, AND WERE RECORDED ON OCTOBER 6, 1879 BY WILLIAM F. EWING, COUNTY CLERK, SAID THAT **HE FOUND THE STONE** AT THE WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 6-17-10 ON THE RANGE LINE AND THE LYON AND MORRIS COUNTY LINE FOR THE TERMINUS OF THE SECOND ROAD ON THIS ROAD SURVEY. **[NOTE:** AN ENTRY ON PAGE 157 STATES THAT THE PETITION OF C. HOOD TO VACATE THE ROAD FROM THE 1/4 CORNER ON THE COUNTY LINE ON THE WEST LINE OF SECTION 30-16-10 THENCE SOUTH TO THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 6-17-10, BEING A PART OF THE ROAD GRANTED ON PETITION OF W. T. KITCHEN WAS APPROVED ON APRIL 15, 1884 BY ORDER OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS SIGNED BY J. L. BUTLER, CHAIRMAN PROTEM AND ATTESTED TO BY ROLAND LARKIN, COUNTY CLERK – WARREN CHIP WOODS, LS. 603, COUNTY SURVEYOR]

HIS SURVEY NOTES SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- 1) THE SECOND ROAD EXTENDS EAST TO THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF THE SW1/4 OF THE NW1/4 OF SECTION 6-17-10 AT A TURN TO THE NORTH ON THE SECOND ROAD ON THIS ROAD SURVEY
- 3) R. H. EDMISTON, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1884 TO 1887, IN SURVEY NUMBER 17 RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "E" ON PAGE 17 DATED MARCH 11, 1884 FOR A ROAD SURVEY IN TOWNSHIPS 16 & 17, RANGE 10 FOR CALVIN HOOD, PRINCIPAL PETITIONER, SAID THAT **HE FOUND THE STONE** AT THE WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 6-17-10 ON THE RANGE LINE AND THE LYON AND MORRIS COUNTY LINE ON TO END THIS ROAD SURVEY.

HIS SURVEY NOTES/DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- 1) THIS ROAD EXTENDS EAST ON THE 1/2 SECTION LINE FOR 1,320' EAST TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF THE SW1/4 OF THE SW1/4 OF SECTION 6-17-10
- 4) ROBERT MILLIKEN, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1870 TO 1875 AND FROM 1882 TO 1883, IN A ROAD SURVEY FOR ROAD NUMBER 243 RECORDED IN ROAD RECORD BOOK "B" ON PAGES 558 TO 560 PETITIONED BY CALVIN HOOD AND OTHERS FOR THE LOCATION OF A COUNTY ROAD IN TOWNSHIPS 16-10 AND 17-10 [PACKET 505 IN THE VAULT IN THE COUNTY SURVEYOR'S OFFICE] THAT HE SURVEYED ON MARCH 10, 1884, SAID THAT **HE FOUND THE STONE** AT THE WEST 1/4 OF SECTION 6-17-10 ON THE RANGE LINE AND THE LYON AND MORRIS COUNTY LINE TO END THIS ROAD SURVEY. THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS ORDERED THAT THE ROAD AS PETITIONED BE VACATED AND THAT THE PARTIES BENEFITED BY

THIS VACATION PAY TO LYON COUNTY THE COSTS OF THE VIEW, SURVEY, AND **VACATION** OF SAID ROAD ON APRIL 15, 1884 AS NOTED BY J. L. BUTLER, CHAIRMAN PROTEM OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, AND RECORDED ON MAY 15, 1884 BY ROLAND LARKIN, COUNTY CLERK.

- 5) R. H. EDMISTON, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1884 TO 1887, BY MATTHEW BROWN, DEPUTY COUNTY SURVEYOR, IN SURVEY NUMBER 93 RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "F" ON PAGE 99 DATED JUNE 17-30, 1886 AND RECORDED IN MISCELLANEOUS VOLUME 36 ON PAGES 495 & 496 IN THE REGISTER OF DEEDS OFFICE ON SEPTEMBER 2, 1886, TO ESTABLISH THE MISSING CORNERS AND SUBDIVIDE SECTION 7-17-10, SAID THAT **HE FOUND THE STONE "SET BY AN UNKNOWN PARTY"** AT THE WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 6-17-10 ON THE RANGE LINE AND THE LYON AND MORRIS COUNTY LINE ON THIS SURVEY.
