

CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 07, TOWNSHIP 17 SOUTH, RANGE 10 EAST

- 1) R. H. EDMISTON, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1884 TO 1887, BY MATTHEW BROWN, DEPUTY COUNTY SURVEYOR, IN SURVEY NUMBER 93, A **PERMANENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "F" ON PAGE 99 DATED JUNE 17-30, 1886 AND RECORDED IN MISCELLANEOUS VOLUME 36 ON PAGES 495 & 496 IN THE REGISTER OF DEEDS OFFICE ON SEPTEMBER 2, 1886, TO ESTABLISH THE MISSING CORNERS AND SUBDIVIDE SECTION 7-17-10, SAID THAT **HE SET A 19" X 12" X 2-1/2" STONE MARKED WITH A PLUS ("+") ON TOP AND ALSO NEAR THE BOTTOM ON THE NORTH SIDE** FOR THE PERMANENT CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 7-17-10 AT THE INTERSECTION OF THE LINES FROM THE OPPOSITE 1/4 CORNERS ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY.**

- 1) 15.44 CHAINS SOUTH TO THE 16" X 11" X 3" PROPERTY STONE MARKED "60" HE SET ON THIS SURVEY
 - 2) 20.00 CHAINS EAST TO THE 16" X 9" X 3" STONE MARKED "1/8" HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT SOUTH 1/8TH CORNER OF THE NE1/4 OF SECTION 7-17-10
 - 3) 40.00 CHAINS EAST TO THE 22" X 8" X 6" STONE MARKED "1/4" ON THE WEST FACE HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT EAST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 7-17-10
 - 4) 19.92-1/2 CHAINS NORTH TO THE 19" X 7" X 8" STONE MARKED "1/8" ON THE WEST FACE HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT WEST 1/8TH CORNER OF THE NE1/4 OF SECTION 7-17-10
 - 5) 39.85 CHAINS NORTH TO THE 15" X 14" X 6" STONE MARKED "1/4" HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT NORTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 7-17-10
- 3) ALVA J. SMITH, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1900 THROUGH 1906, IN SURVEY NUMBER 7, A **PERMANENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "E" ON PAGE 186 DATED JULY 3, 1900 ORDERED BY JOHN DAVIS, SR., FOR THE LOCATION OF THE CORNERS AND BOUNDARIES OF THE EAST 30 ACRES OF THE NORTH 60 ACRES OF LOTS 1 & 2 OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 7-17-10, SAID THAT **HE FOUND THE STONE** AT THE CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 7-17-10 THAT WAS SET BY MATTHEW BROWN IN SURVEY NUMBER 93 IN BOOK "F" ON PAGE 99 ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY.** HE NOTED THAT HE "FOUND STONES AT ALL OF THE CORNERS OF THE NORTH 60 ACRES THAT WERE SET BY BROWN IN SURVEY NUMBER 93 IN SURVEY BOOK "F" ON PAGE 99". THERE IS ADDITIONAL INFORMATION IN PACKET "M 129" IN MISCELLANEOUS DRAWER NUMBER 7 IN THE VAULT IN THE COUNTY ENGINEER'S OFFICE.

HIS SURVEY NOTES/DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- 1) 19.55-3/4 CHAINS WEST TO THE 16" X 9" X 4" COTTONWOOD LIMESTONE MARKED "X" ON TOP HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT NORTH 1/8TH CORNER OF THE SW1/4 OF SECTION 7-17-10
- 2) 39.11-1/2 CHAINS WEST TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 7-17-10 ON THE RANGE LINE AND THE LYON AND MORRIS COUNTY LINE
