EDMISTON, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1884 TO 1887, BY MATTHEW BROWN, DEPUTY COUNTY SURVEYOR, IN SURVEY NUMBER 93, A **PERMANENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "F" ON PAGE 99 DATED JUNE 17-30, 1886 AND RECORDED IN MISCELLANEOUS VOLUME 36 ON PAGES 495 & 496 IN THE REGISTER OF DEEDS OFFICE ON SEPTEMBER 2, 1886, TO ESTABLISH THE MISSING CORNERS AND SUBDIVIDE SECTION 7-17-10, SAID THAT **HE SET AN 18" X 12" X 2" STONE MARKED WITH A "+" ON THE TOP** FOR THE PERMANENT CENTER CORNER OF THE NORTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 7-17-10 EQUIDISTANT BETWEEN THE PERMANENT 1/8TH STONES THAT HE SET ON THE EAST AND WEST SIDES OF THE NORTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 7-17-10 ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**.

HIS SURVEY NOTES/DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- 1) 20.00 CHAINS WEST TO THE 19" X 7" X 8" STONE MARKED "1/8" ON THE WEST FACE HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT WEST 1/8TH CORNER OF THE NE1/4 OF SECTION 7-17-10
- 2) 20.00 CHAINS EAST TO THE 20" X 9" X 6" STONE MARKED "1/8" ON THE WEST FACE HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT EAST 1/8TH CORNER OF THE NE1/4 OF SECTION 7-17-10
