- 1) STEVEN S. BROSEMER, L.S. 752, DEPUTY COUNTY SURVEYOR, IN A LAND SURVEY REFERENCE REPORT DATED MARCH 31, 2010 FOR PROJECT NUMBER 10053-02, A SURVEY OF THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 8-17-10 FOR DON DIX, SURVEY F08003 IN THE SURVEY FILE FOR TOWNSHIP 17-10, SAID THAT **HE SET A 5/8" X 30" REBAR WITH A LYON COUNTY CAP** FOR THE CENTER OF SECTION 8-17-10 AT THE INTERSECTION OF THE LINES FROM THE OPPOSITE QUARTER CORNERS.
  - 1) 16.05' ENE TO A CONCRETE NAIL & BOTTLECAP IN A 12" HACKBERRY TREE
  - 2) 25.55' SE TO A CONCRETE NAIL & BOTTLECAP IN A 12" WALNUT TREE
  - 3) 24.55' SSW TO A CONCRETE NAIL & BOTTLECAP IN A 24" HACKBERRY TREE
  - 4) 16.25' WSW TO A CONCRETE NAIL & BOTTLECAP IN AN 8" HACKBERRY TREE
  - 5) **HE SET A STEEL T-POST ON THE SOUTH SIDE OF THE REBAR**

HIS SURVEY DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

  - 1) 2,633.85' WEST TO THE EDMISTON STONE HE FOUND AT THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF THE SW1/4 OF SECTION 8-17-10
  - 2) 2,646.01' NORTH TO THE 5/8" REBAR WITH A LYON COUNTY CAP HE SET FOR THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF THE NW1/4 OF SECTION 8-17-10
  - 3) 2,630.20' EAST TO THE 5/8" REBAR WITH A LYON COUNTY CAP HE SET FOR THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF THE SE1/4 OF SECTION 8-17-10
  - 4) 2,669.41' SOUTH TO THE 1/2" REBAR HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF THE SE1/4 OF SECTION 8-17-10
