

WEST 1/16 CORNER OF THE NORTHWEST 1/4 SECTION 08, TOWNSHIP 17 SOUTH, RANGE 10 EAST

- 1) R. H. EDMISTON, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1884 TO 1887, BY MATTHEW BROWN, DEPUTY COUNTY SURVEYOR, IN SURVEY NUMBER 93, A **PERMANENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "F" ON PAGE 99 DATED JUNE 17-30, 1886 AND RECORDED IN MISCELLANEOUS VOLUME 36 ON PAGES 495 & 496 IN THE REGISTER OF DEEDS OFFICE ON SEPTEMBER 2, 1886, TO ESTABLISH THE MISSING CORNERS AND SUBDIVIDE SECTION 7-17-10, SAID THAT **HE SET A 20" X 9" X 6" STONE MARKED "1/8" ON THE WEST FACE** FOR THE PERMANENT EAST 1/8TH CORNER OF THE NORTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 7-17-10 ON LINE AND HALFWAY BETWEEN THE STONE THAT HE FOUND AT THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 7-21-10 AND THE STONE THAT HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT EAST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 7-21-10 ON THIS PERMANENT SURVEY.

HIS SURVEY NOTES/DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- 1) 19.93-1/2 CHAINS NORTH TO THE STONE THAT HE FOUND AT THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 7-17-10
- 2) 19.93-1/2 CHAINS SOUTH TO THE 22" X 8" X 6" STONE HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT EAST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 7-17-10
- 3) 59.80-1/2 CHAINS SOUTH TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 7-17-10
